

### Nevada State Licensure Testing Requirements for 7-12 Mathematics Provisional Licensure

In addition to fulfilling the basic competency exam requirement (Praxis Core or CBEST), secondary math (7-12) content area teachers must either:

- Hold a major or minor in Mathematics OR
- Pass the Praxis II in Mathematics with a minimum score of 159 (see below for additional details)

This requirement must be met by the end of Pre-Service Training in early July 2024. To ensure timely receipt of your official score report, it is recommended that you make your final Praxis II Mathematics testing attempt no later than June 7, 2024.

This requirement exists to ensure that licenses are granted to individuals who have the depth of content area expertise required to teach more sophisticated concepts to students across the 7-12 grade level band. If you hold a major or minor in Mathematics, only the basic competency testing section below applies to you. You do not need to register for the content exam.

### Secondary Mathematics (7-12) Test Registration Overview

Below you will find an overview of testing required in order to obtain a provisional teaching license upon successful completion of Pre-Service Training in early July.

#### **BASIC COMPETENCY TESTING REQUIREMENT**

Choose one of the two testing options in the table below if you do not qualify for an exemption. Exemptions are granted to candidates who meet any of the criteria below:

- You took the ACT or SAT after July 4, 2014 and achieved the following minimum score:
  - o ACT: 21
  - o SAT: 1100
- You obtained an advanced degree (Master's or higher) from a regionally accredited college or university and achieved a score on the GRE that was at or above the midpoint of the score range in effect at the time of examination (score report required for evaluation). The GRE score report must be dated after July 4, 2014.
- You already passed a basic skills test that is determined by the Nevada Department of Education to be equivalent to the "Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators" in reading, mathematics, and writing and can provide a score report dated after July 1, 2014 for evaluation.

If you do not qualify for any of these exemptions, please register for just <u>ONE</u> of the following tests unless you have already have a passing score report dated July 4, 2014 or after:

Option 1: Core Academic Skills for Educators	Reading: 5713 Writing: 5723 Math: 5733  If you prefer to take all three sections in one sitting, please register using code 5752.  Individual sections cost \$90 each. The cost for the combined test is \$150.	Reading: 150 Writing: 156 Math: 144
Option 2: CBEST	n/a - you have the option to register for a computer-based or paper-based test session  Individual sections cost \$30 each. The cost for the combined test is \$90.	The passing score on each CBEST section is a scaled score of 41. A total score (the sum of Reading, Mathematics, and Writing scaled scores) of 123 is required for passing status. It is possible to pass the CBEST with a scaled score on one or two sections as low as 37, provided that the total score is 123 or higher. It is not possible, however, to pass the CBEST if any section score is below 37, regardless of how high the total score may be.

# MATHEMATICS CONTENT AREA EXAM (PRAXIS II) REQUIREMENT

If you do not hold a major or minor in Mathematics, and have not already taken and passed the exam in the table below, please register and submit proof of registration.

Please note that the waiting period following an unsuccessful attempt on each of these exams is as follows:

- Praxis Exams: 28 days from the day that your score report is released
- CBEST: 45 calendar days from your last attempt

### **Submitting Proof of Test Registration and Score Reports**

All enrollees are required to submit either proof of testing exemption or proof of test registration AND score reports upon receipt. Please follow the instructions below to ensure that you submit your documentation to the correct places.

• Praxis Core or CBEST Proof of Exemption or Proof of Registration: We are collecting proof of exemption or proof of test registration for basic competency skills testing via the "Register for Basic Competency Testing or Provide Proof of Exemption" link in your enrollment e-mail. The subject line of this e-mail is "Welcome to NTC!" and it should look similar to the image below, with hyperlinks for each task.


Enrollment Task: Official Transcripts




 Submit Praxis Core/CBEST score reports by uploading them to the corresponding assignment in Google Classroom
