
Students can use the Ally tool to translate on-screen text and file content within a course to another language. There are two translation options available to meet student needs.



Option 1: Translated Version

This option will convert content into an HTML web page file that contains the translated text for *offline viewing*.

1. When the student is logged into the course, the student will click the **ALLY** symbol  next to the content they want to see translated.
2. In the list that appears, the student will select **TRANSLATED VERSION**, select a **LANGUAGE**, and click **DOWNLOAD**.
3. A translated HTML file will save to the student's Downloads area on their computer for viewing.



Option 2: Immersive Reader

[Immersive Reader](#) supports on-screen reading with text *and* spoken word translation. *Internet access is required.*

1. When the student is logged into the course, the student will click the **ALLY** symbol  next to the content they want to see translated. In the format list that appears, the student will select **IMMERSIVE READER** and click **DOWNLOAD**.
2. The Immersive Reader will open in a new browser tab. The student will click the **READING PREFERENCES**  icon, set **TRANSLATE** to the preferred language, and toggle **DOCUMENT** on.

3. Immersive Reader will display and read the text content in the chosen language with customizable tools to aid focus or comprehension.

To hear a robot read the text, click the **play** button.
