1. A Burlington lesson is made up of activities. First, read what the lesson is about. Then, go to the next activity. Read the instructions. Yes, you can check the translation icon to see the instructions translated. You will need to be sure to work with others at your table.

2. Complete the activity. Check your work and look at your score. If you would like to try the activity again, click on the reset button. Yes, you can work with people at your table as long as you are very quiet. The more you get done in class, the less work you'll have for home.
3. When you finish the second activity, move on to the next activity. Notice that the earlier activities are in blue. That's because you have completed the activities. You can do this. Think about how proud you will be when you finish this class.
4. The next activity is dark because you are now in that activity, and the other activities are white because you have not completed them. (Download Burlington English to your phone if you have not done so. Use Google play or the App store to download it to your phone.)
5. It is best to complete the activities in order but if you skip an activity it's okay. You can go back to any activity at any time. Make sure you do all of them though. (Oh, be sure that you have enabled the microphone on your phone so that you can record words with burlington.)
6. Look for an activity that is still white and click to return to it as you work through the lesson. You will see many different types of activities to practice listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Please do not skimp, بخيل bikhil, or shortchange the activities that are hard for you.
7. Take your time and have fun, quietly. Try to find other students in class you work well with and try to be here all you can so that you can help them. Feel free to click on buttons and try things out.
8. If you need help, there are tutorials, دروس durus, available. Plan to bring a phone charger with you though in case your phone is not all charged up. Bring earbuds too.
9. After you finish the last activity in a lesson, you can check your progress for the lesson. Progress shows if you have completed all the activities in the lesson.
10. Progress also shows you your average score for the activities you completed and the time spent in the lesson. Click the back arrow to go back to the list of lessons. You did it!
11. You have now learned how easy it is to use Burlington English student lessons. Click on the Burlington English: student lessons home button and select the tutorials tile.
