
## **Exercise 07 Local Server**

1. If you run into an error like this:



This is because Chrome does not allow loading local files by default, see: http://www.chrome-allow-file-access-from-file.com/

## 2. Open up Terminal

Applications->Utilities->Terminal



3. Type in: cd /Users/UserName/Desktop/FolderName/FolderName (the path to your project folder) & press ENTER



4. Then Type in: python -m SimpleHTTPServer (You are using Python's built-in HTTP server, already built into Mac OSX & higher, to turn your local directory into a web server directory.)



5. Press **ENTER** & you will see this:



6. Type in <a href="http://localhost:8000">http://localhost:8000</a> into your browser and your p5 project should show up correctly.
