Equitable Excellence Scholarship

Due Date: December 18, 2026

Amount: \$5,000 for 4 years, or up to \$20,000 - 100 awards

Criteria: Be a current high school senior that resides in one of the 50 U.S. states, District of Columbia or Puerto Rico, who plan to enroll full-time in an accredited two- or four-year college or university in the United States for the entire upcoming academic year, Demonstrate ambition and self-drive to be a force for good in their communities by encouraging others to pursue higher education, Be willing to provide a release to publicize their identities and information about their plans or achievements along with photographs for use in Program promotion/information, Have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale (or its equivalent, weighted or unweighted).

South Milwaukee Industrial Museum - Bucyrus Museum Scholarship

Due Date: April 10, 2026 (Submit application to Mrs. Thiel by April 3, 2026 to mail)

Amount: \$2,500 - 6 awards

Criteria: Eligible continuing education programs and courses of study include Technical College courses in welding, machining, electrical, hydraulic, assembly, etc., or trade apprenticeships in welding, machining, electrical, equipment operation, etc., or four-year programs in engineering related to manufacturing such as mechanical design, weld engineering, metallurgy, electrical engineering, hydraulic engineering, etc. To be eligible, there is a combined household income ceiling of \$125,000.00 or less.

To Apply: Completed [SMIM Application](#) with a letter of recommendation from a school district teacher and short essay.

SCHOOL INFO

ATTENDANCE: Student absences must be reported by a parent/guardian by 9:00 a.m. You may use the online tool (Cudahy School District website -cudahysd.org) [CHS Student Absence Report Form](#) or call (414) 294-2705.

EARLY RELEASE: If your student will be leaving school early for an appointment please contact the school before 9:00 a.m. (using online reporting tool [CHS Student Absence Report Form](#) or phone) to request a pass. The student will be given the pass between classes.

LATE START FRIDAYS -NEW SCHEDULE! Teachers will meet in collaborative teams on the **Fridays** listed on the link. Classes will start later (8:25 am) on these specific Fridays. The building is open starting at 7:15 am every day, so there is no need to change a student's arrival time on any day.

MEDICATION: If your child has a health condition that will require medication to be taken at school you must complete the [medication form](#), including signatures from the prescribing doctor and parent. Meds must be turned in to the office, by the parent/guardian, in the original bottle/packaging.



PARKING PERMITS: All student vehicles parked in the student parking lot must have a valid parking sticker (\$35.00 per year). Students will receive a designated parking space for the year. WINTER ATHLETICS PROCEDURES - HOME: (girls and boys basketball, girls and boys wrestling, and boys swim)

1. All fans will need to enter the game through the Aux Gym Lobby and check in at the ticket table
2. Ticket prices are as follows:

- **CHS 25-26 Students with their ID** - will get in for **FREE**.
- **Non-CHS 25-26 students with their ID**, must show their ID for the **student discount rate of \$3** plus electronic fees if needed. This will include all middle school students as well.
- **Any student (CHS or any other school) who doesn't have their ID**, will pay the **general admission \$5 fee** plus transaction fees if needed.



- All general admission fees are **\$5** plus transaction fees if needed.
- All Senior-Citizen fees are **\$3** plus transaction fees if needed.
- CHS still accepts the following for each event:
 - Cash
 - Purchase Online Tickets Ahead Of Time (Including the 25-26 Packer Passes)
 - At the gate: cash or credit transaction fee applies

If you need a **replacement CHS 25-26 student ID, the cost will be **\$5.00**. Please go to the **main office** to setup a time for a replacement student ID to be made.*
