

As we continue through the 2025–2026 academic year, we are updating our electronic device policy to include a specific prohibition of **smart glasses**, including [Ray-Ban Meta](#) and similar wearable technologies.

Reason for Policy Update

While we embrace technological advancement, the unique capabilities of smart glasses present challenges that are incompatible with a safe and focused learning environment:

- **Privacy Concerns:** These devices can record high-definition video and audio discreetly. To protect the privacy and dignity of all students, recording is strictly prohibited in classrooms, locker rooms, and restrooms.
- **Academic Honesty:** With built-in AI and communication features, smart glasses can be used to capture test questions and receive real-time answers, compromising the integrity of our assessments.
- **Distraction:** Like smartphones, these devices can stream music and notifications, which diverts attention from instruction.

Prescription Lens Policy

We understand some students may have integrated prescription lenses into these frames. However, because the electronic recording and AI components cannot be physically disabled or removed, **prescription smart glasses are still considered prohibited electronic devices**. Students who require vision correction must wear standard, non-smart eyewear while on campus.

Enforcement and Consequences

- **Violations:** Devices will be confiscated and students will be issued a demerit. After the student serves the detention, they will be given their device back.
- **Testing:** There is a **hard ban** on these devices during any quiz, exams, or standardized test. Possession during a test may result in an immediate score of zero. In terms of state testing, students caught wearing the device will be issued a suspension and their test score will be cancelled. In addition, an investigation of search history will be conducted, and students caught cheating can be fined by the state.
