Lincoln, NE -- Governor Jim Pillen signed LB77 into law and wiped out all city firearm ordinances (firearm preemption) across the state.

- Stalkers will get their guns back in Lincoln
- Open carry will no longer require training and background checks in Omaha
- Cities can not require guns to be locked up and away from children anywhere in Nebraska

We shame the Nebraska legislature and the governor for putting their love of a commercial product over the safety and welfare of the public, children, and common sense.

We are the majority. We will never stop standing up for children and public safety. We will never be bullied into silence. Together, we can stop gun violence but the fight just got harder.

NAGV believes that removing authority from city councils and mayors across the state conveys an alarming disdain for the health and rights of the Nebraska public.
