- Growth & Decline Update (including Bond)
 - Declining enrollment in HR—declining birthrates, aging population, expensive for 1st time home buyers
 - 17 elementary schools in HR 10,494 students in 2012 to 6476 projected in 2028 —>2-3 elementary school

closures

- School Deserts, ie Sterling Ranch
- Actual school pairings projected to start in 8/2026
Plan—>Policy/decision—>Implement
- April 2025 will announce what the pairings are and then an entire year of planning for staff etc-no one will lose but no guarantee for position or location

- Pairing of schools=>Destination building; with a successful bond will have money to expand and accommodate \$20 million marked in the bond for this

students

- “Highly likely” that a 6th grader in 8/2026 will be in Middle School (middle school 6, 7, 8th grades)
- Buildings/schools that “close” will still function within DCSD for other uses

COMMUNITY SURVERYS to come from the district

- Passing the bond costs \$0 increase in property taxes!!!!
- Polling is at ~60% for the bond currently

- Enrollment

- Enrollment 278 (projection was 271)—will receive more

money for each student over 271 **possibly 1 more kindie

- Average class size 20
- \$300,000 carry over discretionary funds

- Base Preschool

“Little Pups”—relocated from Coyote Creek; full day 7a-530p preschool+naps and daycare; comprised of 5 teachers +director for 2 classrooms 24 in each

- School Goals & School Plan —Christine Andersen

- Building Leadership Team (BLT)+4 staff with Ms Laviaguerre and Mrs Andersen, addition of “ALL ALL”

MEANS

- SEL, math, literacy and professional learning communities
- Goal— 9-12 most essential pieces of common core, for ALL students will be mastered by the end of the year
- Goal—increasing opportunities for math differentiation, especially for those that are on IEPs, ALPs.
