Concept/use cases

- The app has two kind of roles/logins :
 - One for the speaker.
 - One for the event organizers.
- Speakers enter their profile, link to linkedin/g+/lanyard
- Organizers suggest a speaker, i.e. speaker is added to the database of speakers
- Organizers enter their events/wishes for a speaker/topic/date, reference to events from meetup.com/GDG hub
- Organizers look for available speakers, sees suggestions by the app
- Organizers and speakers agree on a session
- Speakers find interesting events where they could speak

Scope

- Speakers are people that spoke at a GDG event (not necessarily GDG members)
- Only authenticated users
- maybe open up for Googlers?
