Everyone coming will be focussed on giving everyone in the house the most exceptional time they can, whether that be cooking an amazing themed meal, bringing something fun for everyone to play with, or hosting a cocktail making class - we're all going to go above and beyond :D

How long is the place rented for?

Is there a carpool?

What's the plan re corona?

The goal is for this house to be safer than staying in the city:

- Everyone joining agrees to quarantine for 2 weeks prior to joining or get tested
- When in the house we will be quarantining together
- When out of the house it will be limited to our group and in nature
- No guests are allowed in the house, (also the host is pretty strict about this and we'll get a fine)
- i.e. you'll end up coming into contact with much fewer people if you join the house

I'm going to be working my normal week and I'm worried the house won't be conducive to that..

Work is the number 1 priority. Some people will take time off, but a lot of people will be working their normal hours. It's less of a vacation and more of a home.

- On weekdays the house will prioritize work from dawn until 7pm
- There will be dedicated quiet areas and dedicated call rooms
- If you are not working you can only be in a working area if you are not distracting people who are working
- There are multiple laptop areas
- I.e. hopefully it will be better to work in than your house as you'll have proper office vibes

How do I work out how much I owe?

- We've tried to make it fair where people with smaller beds/rooms/shared rooms pay less
- Bear in mind it's usually \$690 a night..!

Can I split the cost of a room with someone else?

Yes! All the rooms have space for at least 2 people.

What if I'm having so much fun when I'm there I want to extend?

That's fine if your or another room is free! But bear in mind we're going to be pretty organized and get everything booked in advance so it's unlikely.

When should I transfer?

The rooms will be given on a first come first served basis, so the sooner you transfer the more likely you are to get the room and the dates you want as a good few people have been invited.

Can I invite someone?

Absolutely! They just need to have a quick call with Viv for both sides to check it's a fit re the general vibe / plan for the house

What if I've paid and I can no longer come?

We're not rich enough to cover your spot, but if either you or us can find someone to replace you then transfers are fine

What's the plan re food?

Breakfast and lunch there will be communal food to sort for yourself, (going to be so cheap buying in bulk!). For dinner we will eat together and there will be a cooking rotation where teams of 3 cook a meal for the house, (Head Chef, Sous Chef and Front of House). This is meant to be community style where we really get to know each other and spend time together during quarantine! There will be help if this seems daunting;)

What if I have dietary requirements?

We'll try to make sure you're covered in the communal food for breakfast and lunch. For dinner this isn't a catered vacation, it's just a group of mates, so to make it easy they will be making one meal without variations for dietary requirements, meaning you may need to sort yourself:)

What's the plan re cleaning?

We will split a cleaner once a week, (it's pretty cheap at \$190 per clean).

I like my own space and time, I'm worried there will be too many people for me in the house

The house will not be at capacity and there is so much space to hermit away. You're not bound to hang at the house, so you can always go walk in the nearby mountains.
