## **EXPLANATION OF DOE HIB GRADES**

The Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) is required by state law to grade each public school and school district's efforts to implement the *Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights Act* (ABR) (*N.J.S.A.*18A:17-46). Through its School Safety/School Climate Team (SS/SCT) each school, by using a NJDOE self-assessment tool, is required to evaluate its implementation of the ABR from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018. The Self-Assessment tool included eight core elements that address all of the ABR requirements for schools. The SS/SCT assigned a rating for each indicator based on the criteria and available documentation. The maximum grade a school may receive is a 78. The corresponding grade based on a 100 scale is provided in the last column.
