Petition: Urging the University of Chicago to Publicly Defend Academic Freedom and Institutional Independence

To the University of Chicago Administration,

On April 22, over 150 presidents of colleges, universities, and scholarly societies — including every Ivy League school except Dartmouth — issued a statement titled *A Call for Constructive Engagement*. Together, they condemned the Trump administration's increasing use of federal power to reshape higher education through political coercion. These actions have led to pauses in research funding, revocations of student visas, and demands for ideological oversight — threats to the integrity of higher education itself.

The University of Chicago did not sign this statement.

As current students of this university community, we do not presume to know the administration's reasoning. However, we believe this moment demands a clear reaffirmation of the university's commitment to academic freedom and institutional independence, principles at the heart of the Kalven Report.

Too often mischaracterized as a call for neutrality, the Kalven Report is in fact a call for vigilance. It affirms that a university's strength lies in its integrity, not its detachment, and that when its core mission is threatened, it is obligated to defend its values and its ability to pursue truth through free inquiry.

We call on the University of Chicago to do just that.

We are not asking the university to take a partisan position. We are asking it to take a principled stand to publicly engage in defense of the rights of students and scholars to learn, speak, and protest without fear of political retaliation. In this time of escalating federal overreach, silence sends a message. So does action.

We, the undersigned, urge the University of Chicago to publicly and visibly defend academic freedom, institutional independence, and the conditions that make open inquiry possible.
