BCMTA Music Camp Scholarship Guidelines

Summer Music Camp Scholarships are available to students of Broward County Music Teachers Association (BCMTA) members for instruments and voice.

- Deadline for application: April 21
- Scholarships will be awarded based upon merit of the applicant's musical accomplishments.

Applicant must have studied for at least six (6) months with a BCMTA teacher.

Applicant must be a minimum of 6 years of age by the application deadline and no older than Grade 11.

Each applicant must submit the following to the BCMTA Summer Music Camp Scholarship Committee by April 21:

- Completed and signed application form
- List of musical activities in which the student has participated, such as:

Church or synagogue performances

School band, chorus, talent shows, or musicals

Performances at retirement homes

Local fairs

Community clubs and organizations

Youth Orchestra of Florida

BCMTA activities (Student Day, Musicthon, Recitals, Competitions)

- Documentation verifying the above musical activities, such as concert programs, certificates, or signed statements from the director of the organization or activity.
- Student essay explaining why he or she wants to attend summer music camp.
- Proof of deposit to the music camp.

The Summer Music Camp Scholarship Committee may award a total of \$2,500 in scholarships across the following three age divisions (amounts to be determined by the committee):

Division I: Age 6 through Grade 5 Division II: Grades 6 through 8 Division III: Grades 9 through 11

Scholarship funds may not be used as a down payment, but only as part of the final payment once the student has fully committed to attending. **Applications and all required documentation may be emailed or mailed with a postmark no later than April 21**.

^{*}Scholarship money will be sent directly to the music camp.
