1. Written Report:

Write a **one page handwritten or $\frac{1}{2}$ page typed** report about a family tradition **OR** about the traditions of another country. Make sure to include strong paragraph writing content and structure.

Include in your report:

- Why you chose this particular tradition or country
- How the tradition got started, who started it, etc.
- What you like about the tradition

2. Activity:

Choose one activity from the list below to **present** with your report.

- Bring pictures or share a slideshow with your teacher
- Bring an artifact or object that relates to your tradition
- Create a poster
- Wear traditional clothing from the country you wrote about
- Share the music from your country or family tradition (send a link to your teacher)
- Your own idea- check with your teacher to get approval

3. Quilt Square:

Use the attached 12x12 paper to design a quilt square that shows a favorite family tradition memory. Bring the completed family memory quilt square with your report. You and your family may decorate it any way you like.

4. Oral Presentation:

You will make a brief **oral presentation** to the class. You will read your tradition report, present the activity that you choose to do, and explain your family's memory quilt square.

Be creative! Make it fun! Keep the project simple!
Activities and presentations should last only 3 to 5 minutes.
