- Ensure curriculum materials, assigned readings, and classroom resources are easily accessible to parents and the public.
- Make curriculum review and decision-making processes transparent and open to meaningful community input.
- Clearly communicate with families when sensitive or controversial topics are being discussed in class.
- Prioritize educational excellence, civic understanding, and constructive dialogue across differences.

I believe transparency and trust between schools and families are essential. Parents should have a clear understanding of what is being taught, how curriculum decisions are made, and how schools are ensuring that classrooms remain welcoming and respectful for all students. Parents should have significant input into the decision-making process.
