Reflection Questions

- Why must vulnerability be somewhat consistent in order for friendships to grow?
- All of us desire to know and be known. What are some good questions you can ask each other in order to practice vulnerability?
- Read the above quote. Why is it important not only to embody a real friendship, but also to make room for someone new?
