 dedicated time will allow us to identify any gaps in our current instruction and
 develop a comprehensive plan to create meaningful connections for students

 promoting online safety, and supporting responsible digital behaviors.
- At the high school level, specifically: We are partnering with the 9th Grade Advisory program to deliver direct instruction on digital literacy and citizenship topics. This instruction will be led by our experienced technology integration specialists and school librarian.
