

Dian Harapan Model United Nations Proposal

1. Program Description:

Model United Nations is a simulation of the United Nations conference where young scholars from across the globe act as delegates of a certain country to discuss topics related to the SDGs and other global trends and issues in specific committees. This year, Dian Harapan Lippo Village will continue its 2nd iteration of DHMUN to encourage the youths to voice out their aspirations in efforts to solve the myriad of challenges set out in the SDGs. We believe that the youth are the ones capable of establishing a sustainable future beneficial for all layers of the society and thus, would like to create a platform for the youths to do so all while practicing their leadership, substantial researching, public speaking, as well as critical and analytical thinking skills. We would hereby like to invite your institution to send 1-10 delegates to take part in this conference that will take place on:

4. Registration:

- Participants are active junior high, senior high, or university students aged 12 to 25.
- Participants may register themselves as a single delegate or a delegation* representing an institution or organization (*a) Delegation: > 2 delegates. (b) Each delegate of a will have to fill in their own registration forms. The number of registration forms submitted by a delegation is equal to the number of delegates they'll be sending).
- Registration fee costs **Rp 150.000,00 (\$10 USD) / delegate.**
- Registration fee costs **Rp 135.000,00 (\$9 USD) / delegate representing a delegation.**
- Participants must choose their first council preference and a total of 3 country preferences
- Before filling in the registration form, participants are required to check the conference schedule and country matrix that will be linked on the first page of the form.
- Participants are required to fill in the registration form with accurate information and attach a PDF file of their Student Card as well as a PDF file of their Payment Proof
- National participants may transfer the registration fee via **CIMB Niaga – Cabang Tangerang, Karawai – A/C/ No. 8001 1689 1100 a.n. Yayasan Pendidikan Pelita Harapan** with a **note stating their full names.**
- International participants may transfer the registration fee via PayPal or Wise (please contact us for more information) with a **note stating their full names.**
- Delegations may transfer the accumulative fee of registering all of their delegates (e.g. Delegation A sends 5 delegates, transfers Rp 135.000,00 x 5 = Rp 675.000,00), and use the same payment proof in all of the registration forms.
- Registered participants will receive a conference schedule link as well as a Letter of Acceptance stating their council and country allocations via email within 48 hours.

5. Conference Rules

- Delegates will receive all the DH MUN-related documents and links via email (dianharapanmun@gmail.com)
- Delegates will receive all the zoom meeting links 7 days before the meeting dates
- Delegates will receive a WA group link (for their councils) as well as a Harvard Rules of Procedure booklet and a Study Guide written by the Head-Chair and Co-Chair 14 days before the conference date (August 27).
- Delegates are required to turn on their cameras and rename themselves with the format of council_country during the Opening Ceremony and Closing Ceremony
- Delegates are required to turn on their cameras and rename themselves with the format of country_name during the Committee Sessions.
- Delegates are required to submit a position paper with a <20% plagiarism rate before 11.59 P.M. (GMT +7) on September 9, 2022. Delegates whose paper exceeds the 20% rate will be immediately disqualified.

- g) Delegates must participate in at least 3 Committee Sessions to earn the right to receive a Certificate of Participation.
- h) Delegates must adhere to the Harvard Rules of Procedure throughout the conference
- i) Delegates must be respectful to members of the Board of Dais and fellow delegates. Disrespectful behavior such as threatening must be reported to any member of the Board and Dais immediately. Under the Secretary-General's approval, the delegate may be disqualified immediately.
- j) Delegates are required to follow @delightsdh on Instagram.
- k) Decisions made by the Board of Dais are final and cannot be contested.
- l) By submitting the registration form, delegates have read and agreed to all of the terms and conditions written above.
