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ABSTRACT

A manuscript submitted to this conference should be prepared in accordance with the following requirements: (1) the manuscript length should be between 2 and 10 pages, (2) A4 size (210 x 297 mm) paper and the standard margin settings (see Table 1) should be utilized, (3) the typesetting of the manuscript title should be 14-point Times New Roman, (4) the typesetting of all authors' names and their affiliations should be 12-point Times New Roman and center-aligned, (5) one blank line between the affiliations and the main text should be kept, (6) the abstract should be up to 500 words, and (7) the typesetting of the abstract and main text should be 12-point Times New Roman.

1. HEADINGS

1.1 Main heading

Capital letters in 12pt bold face Times New Roman fonts should be used for main headings, such as INTRODUCTION, METHODOLOGY, and CONCLUSIONS that follow the chapter numbers as shown in this example.

1.2 Sub-headings for sections

The sub-headings for sections, in 12pt bold face fonts, with their initial letters capitalized, are preceded by parenthesized section number like 1.2. No spacing of lines is left after every sub-heading.

2. MATHEMATICS

Use special high quality fonts for all mathematical equations in the text. Some equations may be placed off the text as:

$$S(x) = \frac{1}{1 + e^{-x}} = \frac{1}{1 + \frac{1}{e^x}} = \frac{e^x}{e^x + 1} \quad (1)$$

Numbered equations should be center-aligned. The equation numbers in parentheses should be placed flush right.

3. FIGURES AND TABLES

All tables must be consecutively numbered. In the text, refer to the table by its number (e.g. "Use the margin settings specified in Table 1."), not its relative position. A table caption must appear centered and above each table.

Table 1 Margins of the manuscript

Margin	A4 (210 x 279 mm)
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Top	25.4 mm
Bottom	25.4 mm
Left	31.8 mm
Right	31.8 mm

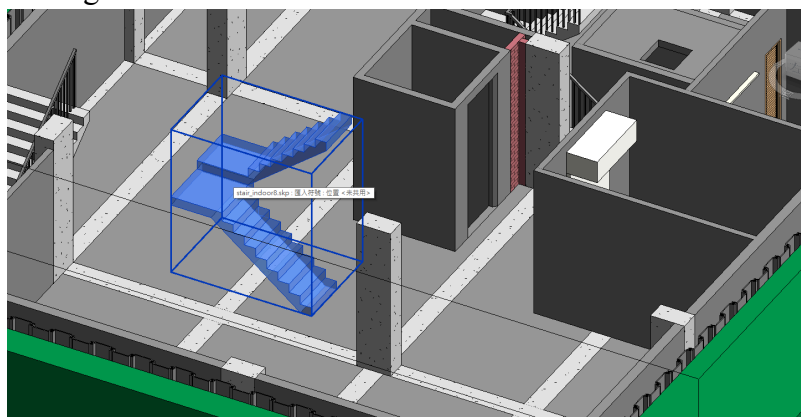


Figure 1 Insertion of SketchUp object into Revit model

Like tables, figures must be consecutively numbered as well. In the text, refer to the figure by its number (e.g., “as shown in Figure 1.”), not its relative position. A figure caption must appear centered and below each figure. Be aware of the size of figures and try to minimize the size of the figures, but not excessively. Characters appear in figures must be legible.

The fonts of figures and tables should be 12 point Times New Roman as well. Captions should be centered like the example of Figure 1 and Table 1.

4. CITATION AND REFERENCE LIST

All the references must be numbered in the order of appearance in the article as shown in the present example and are cited like this [1]. The reference list must be summarized at the end of the main text.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT

An acknowledgment section should follow. Please also list the sponsoring agencies that support this research, especially for MOST projects. For example: **This paper was supported by the Ministry of Science and Technology (MOST), Taiwan, under the grant number of MOST XXX-XXXX-E-XXX-XXX.**
