HIGHLIGHTS

Once your interest in this trip has been confirmed, you will fill out BH-BL's Parent/Guardian and Student Advisory and Consent Contract, in which you agree to adhere to our rules and guidelines.

- If a student fails to adhere to any of BH-BL High School's rules prior to our departure, they may be prohibited from participating in the trip.
- If a student violates any of the rules while on the trip, they may be sent home along with a chaperone AT THE PARENTS' EXPENSE.

Participation in the program is subject to the following:

- Priority will be given to students enrolled in a World Languages course.
- Students must be in positive academic standing passing all of their classes.
- Students will need to maintain a record free of disciplinary problems prior to submitting their application. Appropriate behavior is required throughout the duration of the program.
 - > Student participation is subject to the approval of Building Administration.
 - ➤ Persistent disciplinary issues or concerns will impact your eligibility to participate in this program.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Students must:

- Maintain a record of good attendance prior to travel.
- Request any assignments teachers are able to give out prior to absence from school.
- Make up all work missed during time spent abroad in a timely fashion.

DURING THE TRIP

- ❖ Students are subject to the BH-BL Student Code of Conduct for the entirety of the program.
- ❖ You are an American and BH-BL AMBASSADOR! It is expected that you make every effort to speak the language, participate in all activities, and behave in a culturally appropriate manner.
