This scholarship was established by Wayne and Jessica McPhall to honor Breanna's memory and pay tribute to its namesake.

Breanna was a beautiful red haired, brown-eyed girl who loved her family. She enjoyed playing in the band, strumming her guitar and singing. Having grown up in Northern Michigan she loved animals, but equally loved hunting.

She possessed a spirit for helping others in their struggles and sought to be a light in their darkness. Breanna loved making others laugh; and will always be remembered for her beauty, smile and bubbly personality. Even though she lost her battle with depression, she was so much more than the disease that consumed her.

Breanna attended school in Alanson and Hopkins.

Up to ten total, \$1,000.00 non-renewable scholarships will be awarded annually to graduating seniors from Hopkins High School; as well as Char Em ISD(Charlevoix-Emmet County) and COP-ESD(Cheboygan, Otsego, Presque Isle) school district. Funds for scholarships are allocated through Breanna's Ride, a non-profit organization (501c3); whose mission is to reduce suicide through prevention education and to assist and empower those in crisis.
