For Those...Rosary

Joyful Mysteries:

Annunciation: For those not believing in the incarnation and that Jesus is God.

Visitation: For those needing someone to bring the love of Jesus into their life.

Nativity: For those contemplating or participating in abortion that they will realize it is a life.

Presentation in temple: For those scared or apprehensive about developing and showing their faith.

Finding in the temple: For those sincerely seeking truth and to find it in the body of Christ, the Catholic Church.

Sorrowful Mysteries:

Agony in the Garden: For those needing to realize the effects of their sin affects everyone.

Scourging at the pillar: For those suffering for no reason of their own or due to injustice in the world.

Crowning with thorns: For those suffering, that their sufferings will be used for the conversion of sinners.

Carrying of the cross: For those carrying crosses to find strength & consolation by uniting to the cross of Christ.

Jesus dies on the cross: For those dying with no faith, hope or love that they will accept mercy.

Luminous Mysteries:

Baptism of our Lord: For those baptized to live their calling.

Wedding at Cana: For those who have and need Jesus in their marriage.

Proclamation of the gospel: For those needing courage to proclaim & live to gospel.

Transfiguration: For those needing Jesus' transformational powers to transform their lives into a life of light.

Institution of the Eucharist: For those not believing the Eucharist is the body of Christ.

Glorious Mysteries:

Resurrection of our Lord: For those needing hope and faith, and that they find it in the living Christ.

Ascension of our Lord: For those needing the hope and love of the risen Lord in their lives.

Descent of the Holy Spirit: For those rejecting the promptings of the Holy Spirit.

Assumption of Mary into heaven: For those not believing in life everlasting.

Coronation of Mary as Queen of Heaven: For those needing Mary's motherly intercession.

Divine Mercy Chaplet:

Opening Prayer: You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelope the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

3 Hail Mary Beads: O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You!

Our Father Beads: Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity, of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

10 Hail Mary Beads: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

When done five decades: Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world. (3x)

Closing Prayer: Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon me and increase Your mercy in me, that in difficult moments I might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit myself to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.
