- Use current vocabulary to make up a crossword puzzle using at least 10 vocabulary words. Your clues should be picture clues or written in Spanish. No English should be used. Include answer key. Look under Resources in your Google Classroom to download a form.
- 2. Use current vocab list to **make a set of attractive/interesting flashcards**. Make flashcards for at least 10 of the vocab words, with the Spanish word written on one side and an attractive, colored picture on the other side. Plain flashcards with no pictures will not be accepted.
- 3. **Study current vocabulary for 15 minutes** on Quizlet. A parent must sign a paper saying you did so.
- 4. Make and send me an e-mail greeting card in Spanish. Write at least 3 sentences in Spanish. Print the card as well and give it to me with a smile!
- 5. Using at least 10 words from your current vocabulary, write a 100 word story in Spanish.
- 6. Using your current vocabulary make a TYPED **word search** which contains at least 10 vocab words. The clues should be pictures rather than words. Include an answer key as well as the puzzle.

- 7. Make an **"opposites poster."** Draw at least 5 pairs of words which are opposites. Illustrate the poster.
- 8. Pretend you are on vacation in a Spanish-speaking country. You choose the location. **Make a postcard telling** a friend in Spanish about what your vacation. Write 50 + words and illustrate it.
- 9. Make a **colorful travel brochure** *in English* about a Spanish-speaking city, country, or region in your own words. It should be neatly illustrated, neatly printed or typed, and should include the following information: places to visit, things to do, climate, population, and typical foods of the area.
- 10. Write a 100 word **description in Spanish of a movie or tv show** that you have seen recently.
- 11. Take a story that we have learned in class and **re-write it from a different perspective**. (For example, yo, ellos, tú, nosotros, etc...) Make <u>all</u> the necessary changes for the new perspective.
- 12. Take a story that we have done in class and **change the ending.**Write at least 100 words.
- 13. **Write a sequel to a story** that we have done in class...what happens next? 100 words minimum.
- 14. **Write 20 original sentences** in Spanish using the current vocab list, called "Target Structures" on quizlet.
- 15. **Draw an original comic strip** (at least 4 boxes) and write the script for it in Spanish (at least 40 words). It should be clever and amusing just like the Sunday comics.
- 16. Make an original music video of one of our songs with lyrics
- 17. **Rent a video about a Spanish speaking country**. Write me a handwritten, one-sided paper telling what you learned about the country from the video. (In English)

- 18. **Watch a Spanish-speaking TV show** or movie (like Sábado Gigante). Write a one-page description of what you saw and your opinion of it. (In English) The show should be at least 20+ minutes.
- 19. **Make a silly collage.** Cut pictures out of magazines; glue them to an 8x10 sheet of construction paper. Then write me a story about your collage (100 words minimum.)
- 20. Cut out a comic strip (you may do more than one to get up to 50 words) from the newspaper. White out or cut out the English and make your own Spanish comic. (At least 50 words in Spanish)
- 21. Choose a novel we have read and **illustrate it in great detail** (at least 6 squares). DDD = Details, Dialogue, Dark ink
- 22. **Make a web page.** Include pictures as well as at least 100 words in Spanish about something that is interesting to you. Print out the web page and also be sure to include the web address. Email me the link.
- 23. Make an illustrated **Powerpoint or Prezi presentation** of a class novel, song or story. Wmail it to me.
- 24. Choose a novel that we have read in class. Write a sequel or alternative ending in Spanish. (100 words)
- 25. Using a novel we read, write a 50 word Spanish description of 2 different chapters for a total of 100 words. Use your own words, don't copy
- 26. Choose one "scene" from a novel that we have read in class. On white paper draw and color a picture, collage, or visual image representing the scene and then write 50 words in Spanish describing the picture.

- 27. **Buy or check out a book in Spanish.** Spend at least 15 minutes reading the book at home. Have your parent or guardian write me a note telling me (in their own handwriting) that you read the book for 15 minutes. They should sign the note. (Assignments 28 & 29 must be done with different books.)
- 28. **Buy or check out a book in Spanish**. Read it at home and write a 50 word Spanish book report. Tell me what happened in the book in your own words, whether you like the book or not, if you understand the book well or not, and anything else. (Assignments 27 & 28 must be done with different books.)
