### Layout Assignments

#### Pool A – MPO

- **Saturday AM:** Patriot Blues (longs) (Marked by blue flags at teepad)
- **Saturday PM:** Crossing Blues (longs) (Marked by blue flags at teepad)
- **Sunday:** Patriot Tee Time

#### Pool B – FPO, MP40, MA1, MA40

- **Saturday AM:** Patriot All-Star (Marked by yellow flags at teepad)
- **Saturday PM:** Crossing Blues (longs) (Marked by blue flags at teepad)
- **Sunday:** Patriot Tee Time

#### Pool C – MA50, MA60, MA2, FA2, MA3

- **Saturday AM:** Crossing Whites (shorts) (Marked by red flags at teepad) - 18 holes, no 4A.
  - **Saturday PM:** Patriot Reds (shorts) (Marked by red flags at teepad)
  - **Sunday:** Patriot Tee Time
- 

#### Sunday Layout (Patriot Tee Times)

This is a 20-hole layout with three alternate basket locations (9, 10, B).

- **MPO, MP40, MA1:** Patriot Blues (longs) (20 Holes, marked by blue flags at teepad)\*  
\* EXCEPT HOLE 11: All divisions play hole 11 from the red (short) pad.
- **FPO, MA40, MA2:** Patriot All-Star (20 Holes, marked by yellow flags at teepad)
- **MA50, MA60, FA2, MA3:** Patriot Reds (shorts) (20 Holes, marked by red flags at teepad)

#### Event Schedule

##### Saturday

- **Required Check-in:** At your starting course from 7:30-8:30 AM. If you do not sign in by 8:30 AM, your spot may be given to someone on the waitlist.
- **9:00 AM Shotgun Start**
- **Lunch:** 75 minutes once the final card in your pool is turned in.
- **Round 2:** Shotgun start after the lunch break is completed.

### Sunday - Round 3

- **Tee Times:** At Triad Park. Tee Times will be posted Saturday evening.
- All divisions will play three alternate basket locations (9, 10, B) plus hole A.
- All divisions will play hole 11 red (short) on Sunday, the blue teepad will be covered.

**Playoff Loop:** Sudden death on holes 1-5, 18 from the pads played during your Sunday round.

### Sunday Warm-Ups:

- There is a practice basket and multiple places at Triad Park to throw/warm-up.
- You may not throw on the disc golf course once the first group has teed off.
- The park is open to the public, so please be conscientious when warming up.
- **The Crossing is NOT available Sunday morning as a warm-up course** for your round at Triad. The course opens at 1:00 PM on Sundays.

## Course Rules

### Patriot DGC

- **Course OB\***: Gravel paths and beyond, roads and/or paved walking paths and beyond, shelters.
- All water is casual.
- Paint and/or string may be used to define OB areas.
- \*OB on any hole unless otherwise noted.

### Hole-Specific OB for Patriot DGC:

- **1**: Walking path and beyond is OB. Do not throw until path is clear.
- **2-6**: Course OB\*
- **7**: Gravel path and beyond is OB.
- **8**: Gravel path and beyond as marked by paint is OB.
- **9**: Gravel path and beyond as marked by paint is OB. SUNDAY ONLY: OB on the green/fairway marked by paint. Gravel path in middle of fairway is IN BOUNDS.
- **10**: Gravel path and beyond as marked by paint is OB.
- **11**: Gravel path and beyond on right side as marked by paint is OB.
- **12-14**: Course OB\*
- **15**: Course OB\*. Gravel path beyond basket is IN BOUNDS.
- **16**: Course OB\*
- **A**: Road and beyond is OB. Gravel path beyond basket is IN BOUNDS.
- **B**: Road and beyond is OB.
- **17**: Course OB\*. Gravel path in middle of fairway is IN BOUNDS.
- **18**: Road and beyond (ignore white stakes) is OB. Blue pad – Must pass right side of tree marked with mando sign. Missed mando is required retee with one-stroke penalty.

### Temp Baskets (Sunday at Patriot):

Two temporary basket locations will be utilized in place of the original 9 and 10, plus a modified hole B.

- **9 - 682', 598'**: Plays to the basket in the field across from the normal basket location. Painted lines on green/fairway mark OB lines. Play from last in bounds.
- **10 – 636' 420'**: Plays down the main fairway to a location near 11 blue's teepad.
- **Hole B - 314'**: The basket is on the right after the main gap through the woods.

## The Crossing

- **Course OB\***: Inside any fenced area, fences and beyond, roads and beyond defined by black asphalt, on top of or inside any building.
- All water is casual.
- 2-meter relief from barbed wire.
- Paint and/or string may be used to define OB areas.
- \*Unless otherwise noted on the hole's listed OB.

## Hole-Specific OB for The Crossing:

- **1:** Fenced in playground area is OB.
- **2:** Wall and beyond on left is OB.
- **3:** Course OB\*
- **4:** Creek is casual.
- **5:** Wall and beyond is OB.
- **6:** Creek and beyond defined by white stakes/string is OB. If inside yellow stakes/paint on the hill, play as a mandatory casual relief area. You may pull your lie straight back from the basket, through your disc, to the first place outside of the relief area, or proceed to the Drop Zone with no penalty.
- **7-9:** Fence/string and beyond is OB.
- **10: Shorts** - OB road and beyond on right defined by black asphalt (the string line near the basket defines the OB line between the concrete and asphalt.) The concrete after the string line is OB. Fence and beyond on left, stakes and beyond basket defined by string, inside garbage dumpster fence are all OB. If OB from your drive, you can play from where the disc was last inbounds, replay from the previous lie, or proceed to the drop zone, all with a one-stroke penalty.  
**10: Longs** - OB road and beyond on right defined by black asphalt (the string line near the basket defines the OB line between the concrete and asphalt.) The concrete after the string line is OB. Fence and beyond on left, stakes and beyond basket defined by string, inside garbage dumpster fence are all OB. If OB from your drive, you can play from where the disc was last inbounds, replay from the previous lie, or proceed to the 1st drop zone (white pad), all with a one-stroke penalty. If OB from your 2nd+ throw, you have the same three options but you may play from the Drop Zone closer to the green.
- **11:** Road and beyond on right and beyond basket as defined by black asphalt is OB. Fence and beyond on left is OB. Drop zone is for casual relief (no penalty) from standing water.
- **12:** Fence and beyond on left and creek and beyond on left defined by string is OB.
- **13:** Road and beyond on right defined by black asphalt is OB. Mando left of marked tree. If Mando is missed, you may play from your previous lie or proceed to the drop zone (white pad) with a stroke penalty.
- **14:** Road is OB and plays as a river defined by black asphalt. Hazard is in play and defined by string. If you land outside of the island defined by string, you play where it lies with a one-stroke penalty.
- **15:** String and beyond is OB beyond basket.
- **16:** String and beyond is OB. Mud area marked by yellow paint near basket is a casual relief area. You may play from your lie or pull your disc back in a straight line from the

basket, through your disc, to the first available spot outside the yellow line. A free drop zone is also available as a third option for the casual relief area.

- **17:** Road and beyond as defined by black asphalt is OB.
- **18:** Road is OB and defined by black asphalt. Road plays like a river, either side of the road is in bounds.
