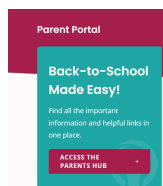
OCSB International Languages Program

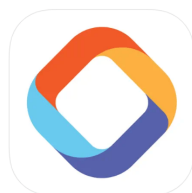
There is also a program for [Secondary students in grades 9-12](#) which includes credit opportunities.
