

Privacy Policy for HabitsX

Last Updated: December 28, 2025

HabitsX ("we", "our", or "the App") respects your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how information is handled when you use our mobile application.

1. Information We Do NOT Collect

HabitsX is designed with privacy as a core principle.

- We do **not** require user accounts
- We do **not** collect personally identifiable information (PII)
- We do **not** collect names, email addresses, phone numbers, or precise location data

All habit-related data is stored **locally on your device**.

2. Information Stored Locally on Your Device

The App stores the following data **only on your device**:

- Habit titles and descriptions
- Check-in status and timestamps
- Notes you manually enter

This data is **not uploaded to our servers**.

3. AI Features and Third-Party API Usage

HabitsX provides optional AI-powered features, such as habit analysis and suggestions.

To enable these features:

- The App may send **user-provided text content** (such as habit descriptions or check-in notes) to third-party AI service interfaces via **ZenMux (zenmux.ai)**.
- ZenMux acts as an **API routing and aggregation service** that connects the App to different AI model.
- The transmitted data is used **only to generate AI responses** and is **not used for advertising or user profiling**.

We do **not** store AI request or response content on our servers.

Use of AI features is optional and initiated solely by the user.

4. Third-Party Services

HabitsX may rely on the following third-party services:

- **ZenMux (zenmux.ai)** – AI model routing and API aggregation
- App stores (Google Play / Apple App Store) for distribution and payments

These services operate under their own privacy policies.

5. Payments and Subscriptions

All payments and subscriptions are handled by the respective app store platforms.

We do not process or store payment information.

6. Data Security

Since all personal data remains on your device, data security depends on your device's operating system protections. We recommend enabling device-level security such as passcodes or biometric authentication.

7. Children's Privacy

HabitsX does not knowingly collect any data from children under the age of 13.
