


## Cloudinary Setup in n8n

#### What You'll Need:

- A Cloudinary account
- Access to your n8n workflow editorStep-by-Step Instructions


#### **Step 1: Set up Cloudinary**

- 1. Sign up for Cloudinary. Visit https://cloudinary.com and create an account.
- 2. Go to Upload Settings
- After logging into Cloudinary, navigate to Settings > Upload > Upload Presets.
- 3. Add Upload Preset
- Add a new Upload Preset with the following settings:
  - Signing Mode: Unsigned
  - Name: e.g., n8n\_upload
  - Folder (optional): n8n
- 4. Click Save to store the settings.
- 5. Copy the cloud name



#### **Step 2: Update Cloudinary info**

1. On the workflow "Step 3: Post contents to Instagram", node "HTTP Request – Upload to Cloudinary (Updated)", update the cloud name created from Step 5:
