Divisions:

Beginner Equitation Division

Riders may ride alone or with a handler

1. Walk/trot equitation flat class – riders are judged on their ability to steer, their position, and their ability to walk, trot, and halt on command
2. Walk/trot command flat class – this is an elimination class where riders will be asked to execute a walk, trot, and halt on command. Entries are eliminated one at a time as a result of the horse refusing to do the commands in a timely manner
3. Walk/trot pole pattern class #1 – riders may walk or trot over a set pattern of poles where they are judged on their ability to steer, control, and their position
4. Walk/trot pole pattern class #2 – riders may walk or trot over a set pattern of poles where they are judged on their ability to steer, control, and their position

Rookie Equitation Division

1. Walk/trot equitation flat class – riders are judged on their ability to steer, their position, and their ability to walk, trot, and halt on command
2. Walk/trot command flat class – this is an elimination class where riders will be asked to execute a walk, trot, and halt on command. Entries are eliminated one at a time as a result of the horse refusing to do the commands in a timely manner
3. Cross rail over fences class #1 – riders' position and control are judged over a series of small cross rail fences, completed at a trot
4. Cross rail over fences class #2 – riders' position and control are judged over a series of small cross rail fences, completed at a trot

Novice Equitation Division

1. Walk/trot/canter equitation flat class – riders are judged on their ability to steer, their position, and their ability to walk, trot, and halt on command
2. Cross rail over fences class #1 – riders' position and control are judged over a series of small cross rail fences, completed at a canter
3. Cross rail over fences class #2 – riders' position and control are judged over a series of small cross rail fences, completed at a canter
4. Cross rail over fences class #3 – riders' position and control are judged over a series of small cross rail fences, completed at a canter

18" Equitation Division

1. Equitation flat class – riders are judged on their position, effectiveness, and ability to execute walk, trot, canter, and halt on demand.
2. Equitation over fences class #1 – riders' position and control are judged over a series of 18" fences with no fill
3. Equitation over fences class #2 – riders' position and control are judged over a series of 18" fences with no fill
4. Equitation over fences class #3 – riders' position and control are judged over a series of 18" fences with no fill

Hi/Low (2'/2'3) Equitation Division

Equitation flat class – riders are judged on their position, effectiveness, and ability to execute walk, trot, canter, and halt on demand. Riders may also be asked to ride without stirrups, to reverse, and to demonstrate a change of lead

1. Equitation over fences class #1 – riders' position and control are judged over a series of 2' or 2'3 fences with fill
2. Equitation over fences class #2 – riders' position and control are judged over a series of 2' or 2'3 fences with fill
3. Equitation over fences class #3 – riders' position and control are judged over a series of 2' or 2'3 fences with fill, riders may be asked to demonstrate a change of gait, to trot a jump, there may be rollbacks incorporated into the course

Rules & Regulations:

- Entries may be submitted through the online forms provided
- Entries are due by end of day Monday prior to each show
- If participants scratch after end of day the Monday before the show, they will still be required to pay the office fee, but will not be required to pay the entry fee or stall fee
- Numbers will not be issued until a form of payment has been left with the office
- Payment may be made by e-transfer to info@stonewoodequestrian.com, credit card (Visa/Mastercard) with a 3% processing fee applied, or by cash or cheque
- Ribbons 1st – 8th in all divisions
- Prizes for champion and reserve champion in each division
- Points are accumulated throughout the series, and at the final show the top three riders in each division will be presented with year end awards and prizes
- Management reserves the right to cancel or modify divisions
- Snacks and refreshments will be available for purchase
- The show will be run in our outdoor ring and classes will run unless there is inclement weather that requires us to pause
- Only active participants and staff are permitted inside the ring, this includes mounting areas
- Dogs and other pets are not allowed on property
