Course Title: Public Presentation (dual enrollment option available)

Department: English

Credits: .5

Grades: Grades 11 and 12 (10th grade with teacher permission)

Course Description:

Students will be asked to prepare a variety of speeches (informative, persuasive, extemporaneous, impromptu and special occasion). Students will also be exposed to debate and develop listening skills in this course.
