

Mazlo Resource for Projects Requesting Payments

What do you need to upload for what kind of payment?

Access your funds to request payments for vendors and contractors. This includes facilitators, space use, participant stipends, and independent contractor stipends, whether one-time or recurring. For any uploaded document (agreement, bill, invoice): include total amount owed, explanation of goods/services, and no tax.

W9 REQUIRED?!

\$600! That's the amount where the IRS requires tax paperwork be completed for any individual or "Vendor" paid. Here is a "[Blank W9](#)" to upload when you're making payments to anyone with the amount's total, accumulated or through one-time payment, is over \$600 annually.

- For any uploaded document (agreement, bill, invoice): include total amount owed, explanation of goods/services, and no tax. The **agreement or invoice must clearly explain what is being paid for, even if brief.** If this is not clear, the payment request will be delayed.
- Someone can receive both one-time and ongoing payments (i.e., a project lead with a recurring stipend, who also provides a service as a one-time payment).
- Ideally, agreements are signed before services are rendered.
- Once all signatories are complete, and documents are uploaded, project leads create the contact in Mazlo. Every payment request must be tied to a **contact**, which projects create in Mazlo.
- Then, Projects leads request payment and upload the supporting document (**agreement or invoice**).
