<input type="checkbox"/> Create a detailed plot line diagram. Be sure to include the following: 1. Exposition 2. Rising Action 3. Climax 4. Falling Action 5. Resolution Include pictures and detailed descriptions of each. Pictures should be colored.	<input type="checkbox"/> Think about the slogan that appears in Ji-Li's first paragraph on page 3: "Study hard and advance every day." Write <u>½ page</u> about how this advice affects Ji-Li during the Cultural Revolution, and about how this advice applies to your own life.	<input type="checkbox"/> From the Yellow Pages in a phone book, pick out 5 businesses that you think Ji-Li would be interested in. Explain why you chose them and how those businesses could be helpful to Ji-Li.
<input type="checkbox"/> Pretend you are going to invite Ji-Li over for dinner at your house. Describe the dinner scene and conversation. What would you talk about? What would you eat? How would your parents react to Ji-Li? Must be at least <u>½ page</u> .	<input type="checkbox"/> Create a Horoscope for Ji-Li. Explain her sign and what is in her future. You must do a horoscope for each month in the year. (12) Each Horoscope should be 2-3 sentences predicting her future, love life, family life, etc. Be creative!	<input type="checkbox"/> Create your own Precious Red Book, like the book Ji-Li was required to read full of Mao Ze Dong's important quotations. Include important quotations from <i>Red Scarf Girl</i> . This should be at least 3 pages long. It should include at least 15 quotes.
<input type="checkbox"/> In her epilogue, Ji-Li writes about her company, East West Exchange, founded to promote cultural exchanges and understanding between countries. Write <u>½ page</u> explaining what you would do to promote an understanding of your country's culture to someone else.	<input type="checkbox"/> Create an acrostic poem using the words <i>RED SCARF GIRL</i> . Include a picture with each sentence or phrase for each letter. This should be colored.	<input type="checkbox"/> Write a letter to Ji-Li. Explain your reaction to her book. What did you like best about it? What worried you? What made you happy? Etc. Make sure all punctuation and spelling is correct.
