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## **What is LifeInvader about?**

LifeInvader is a private state organization that specializes in editing ads, hosting events like the talent show and making news articles and videos that are informative for the public.

## **How to benefit from this document?**

This document highlights our standards of editing ads as well as some important rules we must follow while we work for this organization.

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## Section 1.0 - General rules:

"Buying", "Selling", "Trading", "Selling or trading" are permitted.

For Buying write "Budget:". For Selling write "Price:"

### Examples:

Buying Progen containers. Budget: Negotiable.

Selling seeds. Price: Negotiable.

For "Trading", you do **NOT** need to mention "Budget" or "Price".

### Examples:

Trading "Ubermacht M5 (E34)".

Trading pink Lui Vi pants for blue Lui Vi pants.

For "Selling or trading" you **NEED** to mention a price.

### Examples:

Selling or trading "Ubermacht M5 (E34)" with insurance for "Benefactor-AMG C63 Coupe (W205)". Price: Negotiable.

Selling or trading black Abibas pants. Price: \$10 Million.

- If the ad does not mention a Budget or Price, then you should mention it as Negotiable.

### Examples:

Selling seeds. Price: Negotiable.

- Trading **2 items** of DIFFERENT categories goes under the "OTHER" category.

### Examples:

Selling or trading a house with garden and 9 g.s. for "Benefactor-AMG G63 (G770)" with partial configuration. Price: Negotiable.

The first letter is ALWAYS capital, use a period (.) to end the sentence.

The first letter in Price, Budget and Negotiable should be in **capital**.

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A **colon (:)** should be used after **Price** or **Budget**

## Examples:

**Price:** , **Budget:**

A dollar sign (\$) must be used before the value.

## Examples:

\$100.000 , \$1 Million.

Selling Abibas Pezy 700 V3 Alvah shoes. Price: \$200.000

Selling white Pezy Boost shoes. Price: \$4 Million.

Selling luminous Up-Green Keezy Boost shoes. Price: \$30 Million.

If the ad ends with a numerical value, then there is **no need** for a period (.)

- Use a period (.) instead of a comma (,) for prices.

## Examples:

Price: \$1.000

Price: \$100.000

Price: \$3.5 Million.

Price: \$7.05 Million.

- We do **NOT** use k to represent a thousand or use m to represent a million. Write it out in numbers instead:

## Examples:

\$1k > \$1.000

\$10k > \$10.000

\$100k > \$100.000

\$420k > \$420.000

\$1m > \$1 Million.

\$14m > \$14 Million.

\$121m > \$121 Million.

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## ● 1.0.1 - Terms we see and what we change them to:

- Looking to buy/ looking to purchase **Changes to: Buying**

### Examples:

Looking to buy a house. Budget: Negotiable. > Buying a house. Budget: Negotiable.

Looking to buy a car. > Buying a car. Budget: Negotiable.

### Things to take note when editing ads:

- No need to end with a period after the amount.
- Brands, Locations (certain places are lowercases), Names (first and last name) should be capitalized.
- Please include a dollar sign before the amount, not after (\$5 Million, \$500.000)
- If the sender mentions selling for an amount of items, for e.g 1000 pineapples. **No need** to include a period in between the amounts. Only applies to the value of the items.
- Not sure about the brand of clothing that needs to be capitalized? You may either google it or use our clothing list.
- Make sure to double-check your ad before posting out, make sure the first letter is capitalized and end it with a period if needed too.
- We have the right to reject the ad if it's an improper advertisement.

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## Section 1.1 - Real Estate:



A maximum of **one** numbered property per is allowed.

- We can accept **3 properties** in one ad without the **(№)** symbol.
- Use the number symbol **(№)** if the sender of the ad has mentioned house/apartment/penthouse/mansion number.
- If the sender mentions "Casino apartment" change to "**Casino penthouse**".
- Posting Buying a specific house number is now allowed.

### Examples:

Selling house **№758**. Price: Negotiable.

Selling 3 houses. Price: Negotiable.

Buying an apartment near LifeInvader. Budget: Negotiable.

Selling an apartment. Price: Negotiable.

Selling Casino penthouse. Price: Negotiable.

Selling mansion **№58**. Price: Negotiable.

Buying house **№726**. Budget: Negotiable.

Buying house **№726** with garden. Budget: Negotiable.

Buying apartment **№160**. Budget: Negotiable.

Buying apartment **№160** with 25 g.s and custom interior. Budget: Negotiable.

- There are only **4 types** of garage spaces: 2 g.s. 5 g.s. 9 g.s. 25 g.s.
- For garage spaces, we use "g.s."

### Examples:

Selling a house with 5 g.s. Price: Negotiable.

Selling a house with garden and 9 g.s. Price: Negotiable.

No need to mention the number of days of insurance. Just "**with insurance**" is fine.

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## Examples:

Selling house **No**758 with insurance. Price: Negotiable.

Selling house **No**758 with 25 g.s. and insurance. Price: Negotiable.

- If the **No** of the apartment/house is **not mentioned**, then NO NEED to mention it.

## Examples:

Selling a house. Price: \$10 Million.

Buying an apartment. Budget: \$3 Million.

- Properly capitalize the first word of the location.

## Examples:

Mirror Park is correct, mirror park is NOT correct.

Vinewood Hills is correct, vinewood hills is NOT correct.

- We cannot mention the number of stars of the property in the ad.
- For storage space, use **w.h.** (warehouse).

## Example:

Selling a house with garden and 4 w.h. Price: Negotiable.

- We are allowed to put in garden, insurance, view and other extra stuff like tennis court, swimming pool, helipad, long driveway etc.
- For houses/apartments/penthouses/mansions with **furnished** or different interiors, use custom interior.

## Example:

Selling a house with garden and custom interior. Price: Negotiable.

### • 1.1.1 - Order of the features in a real estate ad (if applicable):

- 1) garden
- 2) garage spaces **(2 g.s. 5 g.s. 9 g.s. 25 g.s.)**

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- 3) warehouses (3 w.h. 4 w.h. or 5 w.h.)
- 4) custom interior
- 5) insurance
- 6) others (swimming pool, tennis court, helipad, driveway, backyard)
- 7) view (Nice, beautiful, great)
- 8) location

- Renting of the property is allowed. Use the word "**Renting out**". Instead of using "Price", use the word "**Rent**".

### Example:

Renting out house №1023 with garden and 5 g.s. Rent: \$100.000 per week.

Renting a house. Budget: \$100.000

- Terms we **cannot** use in real estate ads:
  - Green zone
  - Gang location or any gang name

### ● 1.1.2 - Examples with names for apartment complexes:

- There are 8 apartment complexes in the city.
- Apartments cannot be insured. Therefore, it should not be specified.

Selling apartment №154 in [Eclipse Towers](#). Price: \$1.5 Million.

Selling apartment №163 in [Tinsel Towers](#). Price: Negotiable.

Selling apartment №188 in [Del Perro Heights](#). Price: Negotiable.

Selling apartment №306 in [Richards Majestic](#). Price: Negotiable.

Selling apartment №344 in [Tinkle Building](#). Price: \$950.000

Selling apartment №774 in [3 Alta Street](#). Budget: Negotiable.

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Selling apartment №1790 in [Celltowa Building](#). Price: Negotiable.

Selling apartment №1480 near beach market. Price: Negotiable. (We don't know [that apartment](#) name)

## Section 1.2 - Auto:



- A maximum of **ONE** vehicle per ad is allowed, unless they are trading.

### Example:

Selling "Ubermacht M8 (F91)". Price: Negotiable.

Selling or trading "Ubermacht M3 (G80)" for "Grotti Italia (F458)". Price: Negotiable.

- The brand and the model of the car must be in **quotes** (" ").

### Example:

Buying "Ubermacht X5 (E70)". Budget: Negotiable.

- Any engine, transmission, brake or suspension upgrades to the vehicle (chip tuning upgrades) are all clubbed under an umbrella term - (**Configuration**).
- All upgrades which change the appearance of the car like paint, rims, wheels (except [luminous wheels](#)), headlights etc (service station upgrades) are clubbed under an umbrella term - (**Visual upgrades**).

### Example:

Selling "Ubermacht 760 (LI)" with visual upgrades. Price: Negotiable.

- If the client mentions luminous rims feature, we need to mention this detail as **luminous wheels** in the ads. (without mentioning which [rims](#) and belongs which [container](#))

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## Example:

**Raw ad:** Selling Obey r8 with luminous unique 25 rims from wheels 1 container.

**Edit:** Selling "Obey R8" with luminous wheels. Price: Negotiable.

- If there are no chip tuning upgrades to the vehicle, then no need to specify anything. If there are some chip tuning upgrades, then we use "with partial configuration" right after the vehicle name.

## Example:

Selling "Annis RX-7 (FD)" with partial configuration and visual upgrades. Price: Negotiable.

- If there are chip tuning upgrades and the car is fully maxed, then we use "with full configuration" right after the vehicle name.

## Example:

Selling "Benefactor-Benz 600SEL (W140)" with full configuration, insurance and drift kit. Price: Negotiable.

If you're unsure whether a car actually exists in the city.

Search on google, type the car name and type "GTA 5" at the end, if a car shows up, it's there in the game.

- Upgrades like turbo kit and drift kit should be written separately.
- We are allowed to mention whether the car has insurance. **No need to mention the number of days of insurance.** Just "with insurance" is fine.

## Example:

Selling "Benefactor-Maybach Pullman" with insurance. Price: \$200.000

- Always remember to capitalize the first letter of the brand name and the model of the car.

## Example:

"Ubermacht m5 e60" is NOT correct, instead "**Ubermacht M5 (E60)**" is correct.

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- If the sender did not mention any car brands, mention "Selling a car" instead.
- Don't need to indicate types of cars such as Suv, sports, electrical etc.

### Examples:

Selling a car. Price: Negotiable.

Buying a car with full configuration. Budget: \$10 Million.

Buying an electric car. > Buying a car. Budget: Negotiable.

- Buying/Selling/Trading of bikes/helicopters/boats also fall under this category.
- **1.2.1 - Order of the features of a vehicle:**

- 1) with partial/full configuration
- 2) visual upgrades
- 3) luminous wheels
- 4) insurance
- 5) turbo kit
- 6) drift kit

### Examples:

Selling "Obey R8" with full configuration, visual upgrades, insurance, turbo kit and drift kit.  
Price: \$8 Million.

Selling "Enus Phantom" with partial configuration, visual upgrades, insurance and drift kit.  
Price: \$10 Million.

- **1.2.2 - Terms we see and what we change them to:**

Max config/max tuning/fully upgraded **Changes to:** with **full configuration**.

Nearly max/(part)lvl3 or below **Changes to:** with **partial configuration**.

Body upgrades/body kit **Changes to:** with **visual upgrades**.

Turbo **Changes to:** **turbo kit**

Drift tuning/drift assistance **Changes to:** **drift kit**

Luminous rims/unique wheels **Changes to:** **luminous wheels**

### Examples:

Selling "Annis Silvia (S15)" with partial configuration. Price: Negotiable.

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Buying "Sandking XL" with full configuration. Budget: Negotiable.

Selling "Shotaro". Price: \$500.000

Trading "Toros" for "Karin Tundra 2021".

Selling or trading "Annis Skyline GT-R (R34)". Price: \$1.7 Million.

Selling "Progen 675 LT" with full configuration, visual upgrades, insurance and drift kit. Price: Negotiable.

Selling a helicopter. Price: \$11 Million.

Buying a plane. Budget: \$800.000

Buying "Frogger". Budget: 8 Million.

Selling "SuperVolito Carbon". Price: \$10 Million.

**List of sellable cars:** [Sellable Car/Bikes/Boats/Helicopters/Planes list](#)

## Auto Fair

- Don't need to mention negotiable.

### **Examples:**

Selling "Benefactor-Maybach Pullman" at Auto Fair.

Selling "Grotti Italia (F458) with insurance and turbo kit at Auto Fair.

Selling "Benefactor-AMG C63 (W205)" at Auto Fair. Price: \$1.5 Million.

### **• 1.2.3 - Car rentals:**

Renting of vehicles and renting out of vehicles is **allowed**.

Renting of vehicles can be done up to 21 days.

- Use the word "**Renting out**". Instead of using "Price", use the word "**Rent**".

### **Examples:**

Renting out a vehicle. Rent: Negotiable. (for single vehicle)

Renting out vehicles. Rent: Negotiable. (for more than one vehicle)

Renting out "Truffade Chiron". Rent: Negotiable.

Renting out "Truffade Chiron". Rent: \$100.000 per week.

Renting out "Truffade Chiron". Rent: \$100.000 for 3 days.

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Renting out "Truffade Chiron" with full configuration, visual upgrades, insurance, turbo kit and drift kit. Rent: Negotiable.

Renting out "Truffade Chiron" with full configuration, visual upgrades, insurance, turbo kit and drift kit. Rent: \$100.000 for 3 days.

- For people who are looking to rent vehicles for a Car sharing business.

### Examples:

Renting a vehicle. Budget: Negotiable.

Renting a vehicle. Budget: \$100.000 per week.

Renting a vehicle. Budget: \$300.000 for 4 days.

Renting vehicles. Budget: \$100.000 per week per car. (for more than one vehicle)

Renting vehicles. Budget: \$100.000 for 4 days per car. (for more than one vehicle)

Renting "Truffade Chiron". Budget: \$100.000 per week.

Renting "Truffade Chiron". Budget: \$100.000 for 3 days.

Renting "Truffade Chiron" with partial configuration and visual upgrades. Budget: \$100.000 for 3 days.

Renting "Truffade Chiron" with full configuration and visual upgrades. Budget: \$100.000 for 3 days.

Renting "Truffade Chiron" with visual upgrades. Budget: \$100.000 for 3 days.

Renting "[20 percent](#)" [exclusive truck](#). Budget: Negotiable.

If **rent** and **budget** are specified but **no rental period** is specified, (1-21 days/per week/for 1-21 days) please reject with the message **"Please indicate rental period."**

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**Car list for Rentals:**

(Exclusive and container cars included)

## Section 1.3 - Dating:



### ● Only the following types of ads are allowed in this category:

- ★ Looking for specific person.
- ★ Looking for a family.
- ★ Looking for a date.
- ★ Looking for a wife/husband.
- ★ Looking for a friend(s).
- ★ Looking for a boyfriend(s)/girlfriend(s).


#### ★ Looking for specific person:

- Make sure they mention the **full name** (first and second name) and also reject the ad if they **don't provide** full first or last name.
- Search their name on our database (**Grand RP discord**)
- If the person is not found on the database then reject the ad.

Reason: **Person not found in database.**

- ★ **Exception: If a team member is 100% certain that person exists in the city and is not a leader/deputy/admin, then you can post looking for them. (Updated 11.21.22)**

- Check their **ROLES** to know if you should reject it or post it.



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


The official GrandRP email is the one and only database we use when editing "Looking for" ads.

Step 1: Check GrandRP email to see if they exist (our only database).

Step 2: Check their roles on that server (it is the most up to date).

Step 3: Check admin-list and leader-list.

Step 4: Dating category ads should not be shared back-to-back. (space them with 1 other ad apart)



### ● 1.3.1 - Looking for ads that should be **rejected**: (warning)

- Leaders of a state org.
- Deputy leaders of a state org.
- Admins/gods.
- Looking for a lesbian/gay.
- People looking for themselves or each other. (3 or more people spamming looking for each other)

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- If someone is looking for a state leader, reject reason should be: **You can not search for classified people.**
- We can look for the **crime leaders** and **leader of unofficial orgs.** Also, we can look **administration assistants.**

## Things to take note:

Looking for Leader of an unofficial org. is permitted

EN 02 | Leader of unofficial org

Looking for Admin Assistants is permitted.

EN | Administration Assistant

Looking for Leader of a crime org is permitted.

EN 02 | Crime

Looking for The leader of party is permitted.

The leader of the party

### ● 1.3.2 - Looking for ads that should be **blacklisted**: (warning)

- Buying a wife/husband.
- Troll ads like looking for sugar daddy.
- Looking for a wife and listing a price or budget.
- Any troll name that is not found in the database.

### ● 1.3.3 - Promoting of families is permitted

Mentioning of looking for a specific family is **not allowed.**

## Examples:

Looking for family members.

Looking for a family.

### ● 1.3.4 - Dating category posting frequency.

Dating category of ads should not be shared back-to-back.

There must be at least 1 advertisement from different category between them.

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The fact that it is shared in a row is perceived as an incentive or support for the troll.

#### Section 1.4 - Work:



- Words like "Hiring" and phrases like "looking to hire" and "looking for a job" are allowed
- Use the number symbol (**Nº**) if the sender of the ad mentions a specific number location for a particular job.

**Example:** Construction site **Nº3**.

Construction sites have 3 locations. Please include these if they also include the site number:

- Hiring workers at construction site **Nº1**, on Vespucci Boulevard.
  - Hiring workers at construction site **Nº2**, on Calais Avenue.
  - Hiring workers at construction site **Nº3**, in Pillbox Hill.
  - Ads of this category do not include specific dollar amounts. If they do, you use either "Awarding (amount) bonus" or "Salary: \$(amount)". For example: "Hiring at construction site **Nº1**, in Vespucci Boulevard. Awarding \$3.000 bonus."
  - They are also allowed to mention just "**Awarding bonuses**" or "**paying well**" at the end of the ad without a specific dollar amount.
  - Do NOT use the word "level". Levels represent years of experience that someone has in a job.
- Example:** "Hiring a driver with 3 years of experience at construction site **Nº2**."
- Construction sites have 5 roles they can advertise for:


- ★ Locksmith. (*Lumberjack*)
- ★ Electrician.

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- ★ Gardener. (Farmer)
- ★ Surveyor. (Oilman)
- ★ Driver.



- These can be advertised in the ad specifically.
- If the construction ad mentions more than one of the above roles, change the ad to **hiring workers** instead of naming them all.

People are also allowed to post looking for work ads. That will fall under this category. Work/jobs that can be advertised for are

- ★ Any of the construction site roles above.
- ★ Trucker.
- ★ Lawyers.
- ★ DJs.
- ★ Photographers.
- ★ Bodyguards.
- ★ Professional Dancers. (not Strippers)
- ★ Oil Well.

### Examples:

Hiring workers at construction site №1, in Vespucci Boulevard. Awarding bonuses.

Hiring a trucker with 3 years of experience. Salary: Negotiable.

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Hiring workers at construction site. Salary: Negotiable.

Trucker with 3 years of experience looking for work.

DJ looking for work.

Lawyer looking for work.

Looking to work as a professional dancer.

Hiring professional dancers. Salary: Negotiable.

Hiring workers for solar panel plantations. Salary: Negotiable.

Looking for a job at the construction site.

Hiring firefighters at TV station. Salary: Negotiable.

Hiring firefighters at beach market. Salary: \$15.000

Hiring firefighters at FIB. Salary: \$10.000

#### ● 1.4.1 - Stock Exchange office advertisements:

In the latest updates, office tasks have been brought to the Stock Exchange building. Therefore, it is suitable for recruitment.

#### Examples:

Hiring workers at Stock Exchange office **NAME**. Salary: Negotiable.

Hiring workers at Stock Exchange office **No899**. Salary: \$64.000

Hiring workers at Stock Exchange office. Salary: Negotiable.

#### ● 1.4.2 - Terms we see and what we change them to

Level **Changes to:** years of experience

Exotic dancers/strippers **Changes to:** Professional dancers

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## Section 1.5 - Business:



- **The correct name of business to be used in the ad:**
  - Ammunition Store (*not gun store or weapon store*)
  - Bar (*not strip club*)
  - Car Wash
  - Chip Tuning
  - Clothing Shop (*not Binco or Suburban*)
  - Cowshed
  - Electric Station (*not Charging station*)
  - Farm
  - Freight Train
  - Gas Station
  - Hair Salon (*not barber*)
  - Oil Well
  - Parking
  - Plantation
  - Car Sharing
  - State Object
  - Service Station
  - 24/7 Store
  - Tattoo Studio
  - Taxi Company
  - ATM
  - Juice Shop
  - Burger Shop (*not Drug lab*)
  - Warehouse
  - Pet Shop
  - Exclusive Clothing Shop
  - Jewelry Store

- Only **one business** should be promoted in an ad.

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- Under this category, only buying, trading and selling of businesses are allowed. Promotion of businesses **DO NOT** fall under this category.
- We do not promote personal businesses, instead write "**private business**"
- We only advertise Burger shop business as "**Burger shop**". Avoid saying Burger shop drug lab or drug lab business. You'll receive a **warning** if you mention "drug lab".
- We promote family business.

#### Examples:

Selling family business. Price: Negotiable.

- Ads with prices that exceed **\$500 Million**, change the price to **Negotiable**. (applies to **ALL** categories).

#### Examples:

**Raw Ad:** Buying auto workshop biz for 10 Trillion.

**Edit:** Buying Service Station business. Budget: Negotiable.

### 1.5.1 - Terms we see and what we change them to:

personal business **Changes to:** Private business.

Drug lab **Changes to:** Burger shop

#### Examples:

Selling 24/7 Store №123 near Paleto Bay. Price: Negotiable.

Buying private business. Budget: Negotiable.

Selling Burger Shop business. Price: \$65 Million.

Selling Taxi Company business. Price: Negotiable.

Selling Service Station №113. Price: \$120 Million.

Selling Ammunition Store №34. Price: Negotiable.

Buying Plantation business with 20 beds. Budget: Negotiable.

Selling Cabbage Plantation business with 10 beds. Price: Negotiable.

Selling State Object №260. Price: \$10 Million.

Selling or trading State Object business. Price: Negotiable.

Buying Car Sharing business. Budget: \$150 Million.

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## Section 1.6 - Service:




- Most service ads are found as templates in our LifeInvader discord under the business template category.
- Service ads are ads that are used to promote a **business** or a **service** that is being provided.

### Example:

Looking for a DJ for your party or wedding? Look no further.

- Only 1 service can be provided/ advertised at a time.
- Service ads can contain the word "discounts" **but if a specific discount percentage is given then the ad would fall under the "Discounts" category.**
- Template ads that are different, or not found in the database are to be **REJECTED**.

Reason: Template not found in database. Contact LI to create a new template.



**Figure 1: Example of a template and what to do with it.**

### Examples of service templates:

Juice shop n 179 template 1 - Want fresh juice? Juice Shop №179 in Richman Glen is always stocked up at great prices.

In addition, **office templates** can be shared **only** in this category.

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**Office 26397 template 1** - New to the city? Want to earn easy money, Office (The Best Choice) in Stock Exchange is offering contracts off 90% earnings!

**Office 26397 template 2** - Do you want to earn \$64,800 just completing few easy tasks then go take task from Office (The Best Choice)

## Section 1.7 - Discounts:



- All of the discount templates are found on LifeInvader discord under the business templates category.
- Discount templates are identified as having a specific % **percentage** of the discount.

### Examples:

Chip tuning №4 is offering a **50%** discount all day. Call us for more discounts.  
Juice shop №166 is offering **50%** off on all juices!

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## Section 1.8 - Other:



- A **maximum of THREE items** can be posted in an ad of this category.
- Grand coins are no longer to be posted. Rejection reason -Not found in Database.
- **These items can be promoted in "Other" category:**
  - seed
  - pickaxe
  - mining resources (copper, emeralds, rubies, diamonds, luminous stones)
  - backpack
  - fishing rod/fish
  - Clothing items and accessories
  - batteries
  - canisters (*premium and fuel*)
  - *charger*
  - resource barrels (*solar, gasoline, kerosene etc.*)
  - video card (*do NOT graphic card*)
  - Grand ticket (*do NOT rp ticket*)
  - tokens (*do NOT crypto or cryptocurrency*)
  - Fruits and vegetables (*mandarin, strawberry and pineapple fruits. cabbage and pumpkin vegetables.*)
  - paint can (*do NOT use spray cans*)
  - container (*do NOT use cases/crates*)
  - mask (*Except Balaclava and EMS mask/surgical/covid mask*)
  - pearl
  - hookah
  - licence plates
  - pet (*retriever, rat, pug, poodle, rabbit, rottweiler, monkey, rooster, westie, husky, cat, puma, panther, border collie, pig, panda, duckling, Voodoo doll, Kitty bunny, Ghost and Pumpkin guardian*)
  - Prime / Prime Platinum
  - elixir

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- If the unit price of the items is specified, it should be added as **each** at the end of the sentence.
- We noticed that the term "RP" shouldn't be in the classifieds in the city. We have come to the conclusion that **"RP" should not be added** after the products start with Grand.

### Rules for clothes (if applicable):

- 1) color
  - 2) luminous
  - 3) brand name
  - 4) type of clothing (pants, t-shirt, etc)
  - 5) of type
  - 6) for men/women

## Section 1.9 - Rules of communication.

- Keep your radio on during work by pressing **F5**.
- Correct your colleagues if you see them making a mistake using radio chat or the radio.
- Use a calm tone when correcting your colleagues and do not ever raise your tone or correct aggressively
- Know that it is our job to correct each other so we do not repeat mistakes and that we are not targeting you for any reason, our job relies on us posting ads flawlessly to the eyes of the public.
