## TPC Charters 2023 Winter Event

The TPC Charters Winter Event will be a trip to the ski slopes. We will start the TPC Charters Ski Trip with Fly-In Thursday's group flight to Bozeman, Montana (KBZN). From there the GA and business jet pilots will go to the ski resorts in Wyoming and the Dakotas. The airliner crews will be taking skiers to Washington, Oregon, Wyoming, South Dakota, Minnesota, and Nevada. The event will end on Thursday, December 14 at 23:59z.

Since this mini-event will only last for two weeks there will only be one set of airports released for the event. As usual, there are two separate lists of airports for general aviation/business jets and airliners.

General aviation aircraft will be going to some municipal airports with short runways. The shortest runway will be 3400 feet. Remember that there is the possibility of snow or other inclement weather during the event so be careful which aircraft you choose. You will not be able to switch aircraft.

Airliners will be going to some of the airport near the ski resorts in the north and northwest parts of the US. These airports have runways from 9000 to about 11000 feet.

TPC points will be awarded for each airport visited during the event. Each pilot will receive 200 TPC points for the first time they complete a TPC Charters job to or from an airport. There will be a total of 13 airports to visit, 6 general aviation and 7 airliner airports for a total of 2600 possible TPC points. Also, there is a 500 TPC point bonus for completing either the GA or airliner airports for a total of 1000 possible bonus points.

**Event aircraft will not be ferried during this event.** Pilots will be allowed additional aircraft specifically for the event. Once the event has started, any aircraft associated to the event will not be ferried. Your normally assigned aircraft that is not associated to the event will still be able to be ferried, but flights in aircraft not associated with the event will not count for TPC points. Also, aircraft associated to the event will not be changed during the event so plan accordingly.
