PAYMENT PLAN

There is an initial \$300 Commitment Deposit due upon acceptance. It is non-refundable and will go towards your total balance due for the season upon acceptance. Company families will then make 10 total monthly Company payments. The installment payments are charged on the 15th of each month (July-April). Delinquent payments will result in a late fee and possible disqualification from the program. All estimated costs for the year (rehearsals, choreography, costumes, workshops, competitions, productions) will be totaled and split into 10 even payments. Additional expenses/balances would be billed at a later date. Anticipated monthly installments are estimated below, based on 1 child in company (sibling rehearsal discount not noted). Studio classes, rehearsal attire, shoes/tights/etc are NOT included in this amount. Current figures based on 2023-2024 dance year. Subject to change.

COST BREAKDOWN:

REHEARSAL FEES

Rehearsal fees go towards studio space, facility maintenance, instructor compensation, etc. Also included in this is the Choreography for a Production. This fee is set at \$60/payment for each student (\$600/year). Sibling Discount: The fee is set at \$500/year for each student (2 siblings in Company), and \$400/year for each student (3 siblings).

CHOREOGRAPHY FEES

Choreography is what makes up a dance. Fees are based on level, and go towards compensating the choreographers for their time, talent, and travel. This season we are continuing to try to make additional choreography more affordable and are using a sliding price scale.

CLASS REQUIREMENTS

- -Mini Krew 1 class: 1 Mini Movers or Hip Hop class (based on age/recommendation)
- -Mini company 1-3 classes: 1 Combo OR 1 Ballet & 1 Jazz & 1 Tap
- -Youth, Junior, PreTeen level companies 3-5 total classes depending on genre
- -Teen & Senior level companies 3-6 total classes depending on genre/level

- **-Core companies (Senior/Teen Elite/Teen) 5-6 total classes** depending upon level: Ballet, Jazz, Contemporary, Turns & Leaps, Conditioning, class of choice for Srs
- -Core companies (PreTeen/Junior) 4-5 total classes depending upon level: Ballet, Tap, Jazz, Conditioning, choice of Contemporary or Turns & Leaps for PT
- -Core Youth company 3 total classes: 1 Ballet + 1 Jazz + 1 Tap
- -Hip Hop companies 3 total classes: 1 Hip Hop class + Conditioning + 1 Ballet OR Jazz class
- -Tap companies 3 total classes: 1 Tap class + Conditioning + 1 Ballet OR Jazz class
- -Musical Theater dances 3 total classes: 1 Musical Theater class + Conditioning + 1 Ballet OR Jazz class

Studio classes are <u>NOT</u> included in the Monthly \$ Installment listed at the top

COSTUMES

Costume payments (already included in monthly installment) are the sole responsibility of the parent/guardian. You will need 1 costume for each dance in which you are cast, plus any Company Productions. The average costume costs \$85 for Mini/Youth/Junior levels and \$110 for PreTeen/Teen/Senior levels.

COMPETITION

All dances are planned to compete twice per season. Estimate \$58 per group dance, for each competition we attend. Built into the installment plan is \$58 for each dance & \$65 per Production (for 2 competitions each). Optional solos, duets, and trios are additional.

WORKSHOPS

All company members Youth level and up will be required to attend at least one workshop/convention outside of 24/7 this season, and at least one in-studio workshop (such as eXtreme 14 1-day intensive) at 24/7 Dance Studio. Company members may be required, or have the option, to attend a convention to which we travel. \$400 in Workshop Fees is included in your monthly installment (actual amounts average from \$150-300 per convention and if you don't use all \$400 paid in, any remaining amount will be credited to your account). If you sign up for additional workshops/conventions, there will be additional fees. Mini Company/Krew and Boys Krew are not required to attend, but may opt to do so, however the fee is NOT included in your listed monthly anticipated installment.

FALL SHOW - NOT currently on the schedule for 2024-2025 season

All company members *may* participate in a Fall Show, if we have one that season. All company members will pay a Show fee (already included above), which covers choreography, theater rental, rehearsals, show staff, etc. Does not count towards # of dances.
