- 2. happyiste13.blogspot.com -- I can't remember how they set this up tho
- 3. you can let people vote on reactions to posts and you can use their default descriptions or can change it to what I want -- so they can vote on pictures -- this is in preferences I believe for blogger comments
- 4. Set it up so anyone can comment and turn on moderations in order to use with students

Google Spreadsheets/Forms

- Google Form -- ask for 3 descriptions of ISTE (or summer, or your personality, or of theme, or character traits...)
 - Wordle or Tagxedo
- Google form -- with where are you from (city, state) and something interesting about you.
 - o batchgeo will take all and place it on a map...
 - (tell students that they can no longer live in arizona, and have to move, where in the world would you move...) or (pick landmark from your state/community and place in google form to import to batchgeo) -- dream vacation spot -- what elementary school did you go to?...
 - Student blogging challenge idea -- have them write post for fav vacation spot and then collect where in batchgeo with url link also
- Iste Quiz bowl
 - o can embed in blog in new post
 - can email out
 - o can use url shortener and create QR code for students to go to
 - o must delete rows so you are ready to go again
 - To view answers go to VIEW

 LIST to see it sorted easily -- then "go back to spreadsheet view"
 - Have google form graded for you -- in a template -- 5 question quiz (or select the quiz from templates with number of questions you want)
 - can have your quiz in power point...
 - then teacher enters correct answer at top -- then click score at the bottom (tip 81)
