Call to Order

President Farr called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Police Report

Chief McEnerney has a new officer named Sean Duffy who will be working nights.

Last night, a snowplow hit a raised sewer cap and there may be repairs needed. President Farr asked Sarah to look at the sewer cap to see if there is something that can be done before the permanently cold weather.

Chief McEnerney also mentioned that a few residents and some officers mentioned that they have seen rats and wanted to know if there was a general Village issue. The Chief will check with Glenview PD to determine if they have any information or suggestions.

Engineer's Report

Sarah Ronan discussed the resolution that was introduced to the board.

Trustee Ross moved to approve a resolution for maintenance under the Illinois highway code for \$30,0000 to be apportioned to the MFT. Trustee Landman seconded the motion.

Trustee Landman had nothing new to report. He discussed the timeline for the potential of 29 lead service lines to be replaced.

President's Report

President Farr shared the holiday letter will be distributed in the same way as last year which will include a zelle address for the police bonus fund.

He also discussed that the amendment to the fire contract with Glenview has been sent and we received acknowledgement that they have received the documentation.

Lastly, he shared an interest in celebrating the hundred year anniversary of the Village. He suggested forming a committee to plan a celebration and any additions that may commemorate the milestone and the board was very much in favor of doing so.
