The Vision. Think of that impactful Catholic retreat you participated in and consider: Was the transformative experience meant to be limited to *those* people, at *that* place, and at *that* time? Is the portrait of faith meant to be like a “connect the dot” picture or a textured, rich, and vibrant Rembrandt? We believe God made our homes and your family, those people, to be that place *always*. We believe that an authentic life in Jesus Christ is not limited to a special program but is the purpose of home, such that it reverberates throughout generations. We believe this is possible. And when lived, it is extraordinarily attractive. This is how we build the Kingdom. Image Trinity exists to make this happen.

Roots. This movement springs from the heart of Pope St. John Paul’s prolific proclamation: “The future of humanity passes by way of the family.” Conversation after conversation about the problems besieging humanity comes down to one solution: reclaiming and forming marriages and families as God intended. We hold a strong conviction in the importance of attending to the roots, without which all ministerial impact will wither, with which it will thrive. With over a decade of tremendous impact, here are the critical components of our vision:

1. Cultivating Saint-Making Cultures in Homes: While impactful evangelistic events sow seeds of faith or provide opportunities for initial encounter, our focus extends beyond mere moments to nurturing and fostering these seeds and encounters into vibrant, saint-making cultures within homes. Without this foundation, there is a risk of forming “Catholic program junkies” rather than fervent disciples of Jesus Christ living out the Image of the Trinity in their domestic church. We answer the question following events, “And then what?” And not just for a moment but as a way of life.

2. Enduring Success and Transformative Impact: Our movement has profoundly transformed individuals and families. 3. Promise of Diocesan and Parish Transformation: Our movement’s potential impact extends beyond individual homes. It promises to transform parishes, dioceses, and secular culture by reshaping the spiritual fabric of homes. We speak of “cross metrics,” where the vertical beam of deepening discipleship holds up the horizontal beam of multiplying disciples.

4. Cost-Efficient Scalability: Our approach to transformation leverages existing infrastructure within churches and homes, making scalability across the United States feasible and highly cost-efficient. Furthermore, our extensive network within the Catholic community positions us strategically to capitalize on existing resources and support.
