

Social Media Awareness Campaign on Culture and Mental Health: Student Instructions Worksheet

Objective:

To create a social media campaign that raises awareness about the intersection of culture and mental health.

Instructions:

1. Choose a Topic (30 minutes)

- In your group, select an aspect of culture and mental health you want to address. Here are some ideas:

 - The importance of cultural competence in mental health care

2. Research (30 minutes)

- Use reliable sources like academic articles, reputable websites, or books.

3. Create Your Campaign (1 hour)

 - **Posters or Infographics:** Create visuals that summarize your key messages. Use Canva or poster paper.
 - **Sample Social Media Posts:** Write engaging captions and design images for platforms like Instagram, Twitter, or Facebook.
 - **Hashtags:** Create unique and memorable hashtags that encapsulate your campaign theme.

4. Prepare Your Presentation (30 minutes)

- Prepare to present your campaign to the class. Include:
 - Your chosen topic and its significance
 - Key messages and visuals from your campaign
 - Your intended audience and how you plan to engage them

5. Present Your Campaign (30 minutes)

- Share your campaign with the class. Be prepared to answer questions and discuss your creative choices.

6. Reflect (20 minutes)
