Getting Started Thinking About Your NVHS Culminating Project

Directions: Please answer the following questions as completely as you can. These questions are designed to get your thinking organized around your Senior Culminating Project. You will review this form with your Advisor, and from these ideas develop a Culminating Project Proposal and Rubric.

What are your strengths? How will these be drawn into your project?

What are your weaknesses? What areas do you struggle with? What support might you need for your project or during Stage II, around these identified areas?

What idea or ideas do you have for a Culminating Project and why?

How does your Culminating Project connect to what your *path* is? How does it connect with what comes after high school for you?

What knowledge, skills and experience do you *already* have that will help you carry out your Culminating Project?

What knowledge, skills and abilities do you *hope to gain* from completing your Culminating Project?

How will your learning throughout your project be demonstrated for others to see? How will it be measured? How will it be documented? What specific products will demonstrate your work on and completion of your Culminating Project?
