We are excited that you are planning to submit a piece of artwork for the annual Black History Month Art Show! **We encourage you to submit all forms of art - paintings, drawings, photos, digital art, short films (2 min. max.), poems, dances, music, etc.**

The event will be held on Wednesday, February 25, 6-7 pm, at the Hart District Administrative Center. Your friends and family are invited to attend.

Next steps:

You must submit a copy, photo, or video of your completed piece by **February 16** at: <https://forms.gle/BAnWQVWzWodVWmfM7>

You will also be asked to give your artwork a title and write two to four sentences about your piece – what it means, what inspired you, etc. The planning committee will review your artwork and contact you if additional information is needed.

Bring your art piece to your school office manager or the Hart District Administrative Center between **February 17-18**. (If you created a digital art piece, we need a printed copy.) We will pick up your pieces from the schools and store them carefully until the show.

Plan to join us at the event as we celebrate your art! Each artist will be given one-minute to introduce their piece.
