Supplies:

- Stamp Sets: Snowy Wonder (164334); Falling Snow (164312)
- Cardstock (CS) and Paper: Basic White (159276);
 Misty Moonlight (153081)
- Stamp Pads: Boho Blue (161650); Misty Moonlight (153118); Granny Apple Green (147095); Pecan Pie (161665); Real Red (147084); Versamark (102283)
- Tools: Snowy Wonder Dies (164124); Blending Brushes (153611); Basics Wow! Embossing Powder (165679); Heat Tool (129053)
- Miscellaneous: Stampin' Dimensionals (104430);
 Mini Stampin' Dimensionals (144108); Stampin'
 Seal Adhesive (152813); Multi-Purpose Liquid Glue (110755); Real Red and White Baker's Twine (164051); Iridescent Faceted Gems (163368)



Measurements:

- Misty Moonlight: 8 1/2" x 5 1/2", score at 4 1/4"
- Basic White: 3 3/4" x 3 3/4", 4" x 5 1/4", plus scraps

Instructions:

- 1. Using Versamark Ink, stamp the Falling Snow stamp onto the 3 3/4" x 3 3/4" Basic White square. Heat emboss with clear embossing powder.
- Using Blending Brushes, sponge a night sky onto the panel, starting with Boho Blue, and adding Misty Moonlight towards the top. Wipe off excess ink with a soft cloth or paper towel.
- 3. Die cut snow globe and base from the large piece of Basic White (cut the base from the center of the snow globe.)
- 4. Adhere sponged square to card base, making sure it lines up with the die cut layer.
- 5. Attach die cut layer with Dimensionals.
- 6. On Basic White scraps, stamp the cabin with Pecan Pie ink, the trees with Granny Apple Green Ink, and the sentiment onto the snow globe base with Real Red ink. Die cut the cabin and trees.
- 7. Using Misty Moonlight ink, lightly sponge around the edge of the snow globe base and attach to the card front with Dimensionals.
- 8. Arrange the cabin and trees in and around the snow globe and attach with Dimensionals.
- 9. Tie a bow with the baker's twine, and tuck under the snow globe base, securing with a glue dot.
- 10. Embellish with gems.
