With a huge admiration and respect may this letter be to find you health and happiness. For your kind eloquence I shall submit my letter in your "Royal Norwegian Embassy in Dhaka" reference to the above. I am Rajuma Begum bin pop's name. Nurul Salam however, I'm one of the Rohingya persecuted minority women from the world's largest refugee camp Cox's Bazar in Bangladesh. I'm a Rohingya genocide or Holocaust survivor of Myanmar. I registered with the UNHCR in Bangladesh in 2017 also This is my UNHCR Card P57-00089655. I have been in a Bangladesh refugee camp at least 7.5 years ago without returning back home being upon refugee life.

Indeed, I'm struggling with my little four children under 18 years old. There are fatherless children at the moment. In 2012, the brutal military of Myanmar was hidden from my little children. Unfortunately, we still don't know if he is alive or not . Now my children without a father are called orphans. From 2017 to now how can I suffer and struggle no one does know but only Allah can my struggling with my little children in camp. To bring a good person into every child's life is the responsibility of every parent. Now my children appear in my eyes in a very very frail condition and myself always considering what's life being upon unescaped in prison or jail in camp. It is too severe and adversity.

In camp, always occurring human trafficking, upon kids and children under 18 years old. No life security, no safe place for gathering .. in this year separately occurring human trafficking to every child . I'm ne

I have my Wife and my Daughter with me. Both of them don't have UNHCR cards. She only has a Marriage Certificate. And my Daughter with the Birth Certificate, I would like to seek your authority for a Malaysian UNHCR Card for both of them. I really need a card for them. With the card we are able to go to the hospital for check ups which will be easy without any problem. And we want to go to a third country where we can settle our life and have a better

life. I am only working as a contractor and also doing odd jobs to feed my family. I am working hard because I really need the finance to support my family. Moreover, the price of things has been raised. And also our rent had been raised. Things are not the same as before.

I am pleading with the UNHCR Office to allow them to have a card so that it will be easier for us to be together and do things together. I would be very grateful if you could give me an opportunity to attend an interview as soon as possible.
