Thank you for your commitment to serve as liturgist. We welcome all members and friends to be active participants in worship and bring their own personal flair. Hopefully this task will be an uplifting experience for you. Thank you for your service!

Here are some tips and reminders:

- The bulletin can be found on the [website here](#). They are usually posted by Friday afternoon. The first reading can be found in the worship order before the hymn of preparation. If the call to worship is not printed in the bulletin, the pastor will provide it for you.
- [Click here](#) to look up your reading if you'd like to practice. Change to New Revised Standard Version or NRSV to retrieve the version printed in our pew bibles.
- Plan to arrive about 15 minutes before worship to check in with the pastor about any changes and test the microphone. Please adjust the microphone so it's in front of your mouth.
- Introduce the scripture by book, chapter, and verse. If listed, read the page number and indicate old or new testament (listed OT or NT). At the end of the reading, you may say "Here ends the reading" or "The word of the Lord" or "Thanks be to God for his word", and then return to your seat.
- When reading, speak slowly and clearly. Keep the pace slow enough so that those who are reading along can keep up with you.
- Please notify the office administrator if your plans change so the correct name can be included in the bulletin.
