How to Know It's Working

Since Brisk is already installed in your browser, look for the **small "B" icon** in the bottom right corner of your screen. You can use Google to sign in using your email and password. If you don't see it, you can go here to install: <https://url.lcisd.net/gsk>

- **The "B" is your toolkit:** If you see it, Brisk can work with whatever you are currently looking at.
- **Works Where You Work:** The icon appears on Google Docs, Google Slides, YouTube, and almost any website or news article.
- **Out of the Way:** You can click and drag the "B" to any part of your screen if it is covering something important.

Safe and Secure for School

Brisk was designed with school district standards in mind to ensure your data and your students' data remain protected.

- **Privacy First:** Brisk is fully **FERPA and COPPA compliant**.
- **Free Version:** All features listed here are available in the free version of Brisk.
- **Trustworthy:** It does not sell user data and is designed specifically for the K-12 environment.

Your First Lesson: Step-by-Step

You can use Brisk to build a complete lesson in under two minutes. Try this:

1. **Find Your Content:** Open a YouTube video or a news article related to your current unit.
2. **Launch the "B":** Click the Brisk icon in the bottom right.
3. **Create a Lesson Plan:** Click **Create > Lesson Plan**. Brisk will read the page and draft a full plan in a Google Doc, including objectives and standards.
4. **Add a Presentation:** Go back to that same video or article. Click the "B" > **Create > Presentation**. Brisk will generate a Google Slides deck based on the content.
5. **Generate an Assessment:** Click the "B" > **Create > Quiz**. Brisk will build a Google Form or Doc quiz with an answer key included.

Efficiency and Accommodations

Brisk acts as a high-speed assistant to help you differentiate for every learner in your room.

- **Instant Leveling:** Found a great article that is too hard for some students? Click **Change Level** to rewrite it for a lower grade level instantly.
- **Translation:** Translate any resource into over 30 languages with one click to support ELL students.
- **Targeted Feedback:** Open a student's Google Doc, click the "B", and select **Give Feedback**. It will provide "Glows and Grows" based on the writing, saving you hours of grading.
- **Inspect Writing:** Use the "Inspect" tool on any Google Doc to see a video replay of the student's writing process, helping you understand their progress and ensure academic integrity.
