## **How do I apply for admissions so that my children can take classes through One Day Academy?**

Admission to One Day Academy is done by family.

Families can apply for admissions to One Day Academy by clicking [HERE](#). This is required for any family who has never been part of One Day Academy in the past, or who has been inactive from One Day Academy for 3 years or more. Families who have been active in One Day Academy in the previous 3 years do not have to apply.

## **How do I enroll my child with One Day Academy for the 2025 – 2026 academic year?**

All students must enroll with One Day Academy for the 2025 – 2026 academic year before they register for specific classes with specific faculty members.

Students whose family has been through an interview and received a family number can enroll for the 2025 – 2026 academic year by clicking [HERE](#).

Once you complete the Annual Student Enrollment Form, the parent must pay the Annual Family Fee of \$125 per family for the year. (This amount is discounted to \$100 until June 30.) This amount is per family, regardless of how many students you are enrolling. You can find the payment portal by clicking [HERE](#). One option is to pay by Paypal. You do not need a Paypal account to complete this process – any credit card may be used to complete this transaction. You may also pay this amount by Zelle if your bank is a member institution.

## How do I register my child for a specific course with a specific faculty member?

Once you have enrolled your student for the 2025 – 2026 academic year, and paid the Annual Family Fee, you may register your student for specific classes with specific faculty members.

Families register their students for specific classes by registering with the faculty member offering that class. The complete list of faculty members, with links to their faculty pages is found by clicking [HERE](#).

The link to the class registration form is found on the COURSE INFORMATION page of each faculty member.

## How much does One Day Academy cost?

### Cost of Participating in One Day Academy

Enrollment in One Day Academy involves four distinct categories of expenses, as outlined below for the 2025–2026 academic year:

1. **Annual Family Enrollment Fee** Families pay a one-time annual enrollment fee of \$125 to One Day Academy. This fee covers all children in the family and is required only after the family has completed the interview process, been accepted, and received a family number. Payment is not due until acceptance is confirmed.
2. **Course Registration Fee** A registration fee is paid directly to each faculty member for every student enrolled in their class. The amount varies by discipline, faculty member, and geographic region, as it is individually determined by each instructor. All faculty members charge a registration fee.
3. **Curriculum Costs** Families are responsible for purchasing the required curriculum materials for each course in which a student is enrolled. Curriculum requirements differ by class, but every course has specific materials that must be obtained prior to the start of instruction.
4. **Tuition** Tuition is charged for each course in which a student is enrolled and is set individually by the faculty member. Payment is made directly to the instructor and may be arranged in one of the following ways:
  - Full-year payment
  - Semester payment
  - Monthly installments

Monthly tuition is due by the first-class meeting of each month. Payment schedules typically run from August through April or September through May, depending on the region.

1. These fees collectively enable families to participate in One Day Academy's classes and ensure instructors are appropriately compensated for their teaching services.
