<p><u>Schedule Questions:</u> What does a normal day look like?</p> <p>What Schedule will they have online?</p> <p>What schedule will they have for hybrid?</p>	<p>Students choosing hybrid instruction will attend all classes on campus on their scheduled days. They will attend via Zoom on the days when they are not in school.</p> <p>What schedule will they have on online school? Students online will follow the 10:30-4pm bell schedule. Advisory will be on Wednesdays only from 10:30 – 11:20 (50 minutes)</p> <p>Once the teachers (who want to vaccinate) are all completely vaccinated are we going back to a normal schedule and normal activities? If so, here are the expectations: EXPECTATIONS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On a daily basis, students need to log into Zoom classes (10:30-4:00), engage in lessons, and complete the assigned work. • Any students needing assistance should email their teachers and/or attend office hours. • Remote students should check their Google Classroom daily to determine their class zoom times and daily schedule. • YES!
