Students, Parents, Guardians:

The LCHS art curriculum is based on the Tennessee Fine Arts Curriculum Standards. Students will learn and use the elements and principles of design, art history, and art foundations.

Visual Arts I Prerequisites: None; Teacher recommendation required for retake

This course will guide students to express ideas through different mediums and manipulations of techniques used by master artists. The students will learn and use the Elements and Principles of Design. Students will demonstrate an understanding of how art is used to communicate ideas and how many artists have used art to produce images found in daily life.

Visual Arts II Prerequisites: Visual Art I with passing grade; Teacher recommendation required for retake Students will learn and use the Elements and Principles of Design. Techniques and ideas from successful artists will be taught to provide students with a better understanding of art and its history.

Visual Arts III Prerequisites: Visual Art I and II with passing grades; Teacher recommendation required for retake Advanced Art will expand on the techniques and skills learned in Drawing & Painting and Sculpture & Ceramics. Students will have both small and large format learning-based projects to complete during class. Students will also be required to create, maintain, and submit a portfolio during the class. Students enrolling in this class should enjoy working with visual art, be self-motivated, and be able to complete projects independently.

Access to instructional materials statement:

Parents are encouraged to join Canvas through the Canvas Parent App if they would like access to instructional materials. Skyward is still our primary grade book and is considered to be the official grading system for all courses at Lenoir City High School. We encourage all families to use their Skyward Parent Access accounts for current attendance and grading information.

Grades will be taken weekly. All assignments and requirements are published in Canvas. Students will receive a 100% or 0% for projects/ written assignments. All assignments are open for feedback for students to make adjustments for full credit. Partial credit and extra credit will not be given.
