RULES

- 1. Contestants must be currently enrolled in piano lessons at the University of Arizona School of Music. First place winners in previous Lois Trester Piano Competitions are ineligible.
- 2. Programs must be 18-25 minutes, first note to last, including pauses. If a program does not reach 18 minutes or exceeds 25 minutes the contestant will be disqualified.
- 3. The program should consist of contrasting solo piano compositions representing more than one style or period as well as a variety of pianistic demands. Performers may not program repertoire previously submitted for the Lois Trester or Michael Moore Competitions.
- 4. The program must include at least one significant solo piano work by a Latin American composer.
- 5. The program must be performed from memory; with approval of the KA faculty, students may use scores for certain modern works.
- 6. No changes to the program are permitted between the Preliminary and Final rounds.
- 7. Application deadline: Friday, February 2nd at 5pm submit your completed application to Dr. Lin (<u>fanyalin@arizona.edu</u>) in Word format along with a recent photograph in JPEG format. Copy your piano professor on the email so they can indicate approval of your application.
- 8. Five finalists will be selected from the Preliminary round. The top four of the five finalists will perform in the Final Round. If one of the first four finalists withdraws from the competition, the fifth finalist will be invited to compete.
- 9. Judges selected by the SoM piano faculty will adjudicate both rounds of the competition.
