Temple Construction Progress Report (current as of 4/1/21)

Preliminary Notes: The Church has **231** temples in various phases. Of those, **168** are currently operating. Opening dates for **2** temples are expected to be announced once large gatherings are deemed safe. Another **29** are in various phases of construction. Additionally, full-scale construction is pending for **4** other temples.

A total of **9** previously-dedicated temples are in various stages of renovation. That includes **2** completed temples for which reopening arrangements have been delayed due to COVID-19; **2** more anticipated to be completed in 2021; **2** others for which completion is anticipated during 2022; and **2** pioneer-era temples, with the closure of **1** other pioneer-era temple set to occur later this year.

Groundbreakings have been scheduled for 2 more temples, and there is enough information on 7 others to consider them as being in a "Groundbreaking Anticipated" status. The announcement of official details is pending for 5 more temples. The remaining 14 temples are announced.

Thus far in his prophetic administration, President Nelson has announced 49 new temples. Recent statements from apostles (including and especially President Nelson himself) have noted that the total number of temples will increase ten-fold. With no signs of slowing down, the Church is well on track to have a minimum of 200 operating temples by or before the Church's bicentennial anniversary (which will be observed on Saturday, April 6, 2030).

Between today and that day, there are 9.01 years within which to dedicate the remaining 32 temples, which could be done if an average of 3.55 temples were dedicated each year. And within the next year alone, if COVID-19 conditions permit, a minimum of 8 temples could be dedicated

Due to COVID-19 restrictions on large public gatherings, all temple open houses and dedications/rededications have been postponed and may continue to be postponed until the last four or five months of 2021. The completion estimates below reflect the fluctuation of circumstances based on if, how, and to what extent COVID-19 has impacted or may yet impact those events.

¹ Although the temples in this section have been completed and are awaiting dedications, those events will take place once it is safe to do so in each temple city. The temples in this section are listed in their completion order, but the subsequent dedication order for any or all of them may differ, based on COVID-19 conditions and the resulting regulations for large public gatherings in any of these cities.

- 180. Urdaneta Philippines Temple: Scaffolding erected around the exteriors of the temple and accommodation center; interior framing progressing; completion estimated sometime during *late* 2022.
- 181. Richmond Virginia Temple: Stone cladding begins on south side of temple; power lines buried; roof deck attached to stake center; completion estimated sometime during *late 2022*.

- 186. Bentonville Arkansas Temple: Structural framing started; stake pavilion relocation completed; renovation of stake center nearing completion; completion estimated sometime during *late 2022-early 2023*.
- 187. McAllen Texas Temple: Foundation and utility work underway; completion estimated sometime during *late 2022-early 2023*.

188. Orem Utah Temple: Structural steel framing begins; pouring main level footings; completion estimated sometime during *late 2022-early 2023*.

- 196. Red Cliffs Utah Temple: Pouring basement walls and additional footings inside temple footprint; completion estimated sometime during *mid-to-late 2023*.
- 197. Davao Philippines Temple: Site clearing and grading underway; completion estimated sometime during *late 2023*.

Note: A short time after this temple was announced, some information from my Church member contact in Central America indicated that the temple in this area was likely to be built in either Villa Nueva or Mixco.

<u>228.</u> Sao Paulo East Brazil Temple: Planning and approval phase; awaiting official site announcement.

Note: A short time after this temple was announced, someone living near Sao Paulo Brazil mentioned on the Church Growth blog that this temple could potentially be built in Guarulhos, Santo André, or Diadema.

<u>229.</u> Santa Cruz Bolivia Temple: Planning and approval phase; awaiting official site announcement.

<u>230.</u> Russia Temple: Planning and approval phase; city not yet specified; awaiting official site announcement.

Note: Although it may be some time before the location of this temple is announced and construction can get underway, information of which I became aware a few months after this temple was announced indicated that the most likely location for it would be in Moscow, the Russian capital city.

231. Shanghai China Temple: Status unknown.
