For students in grades 1 through 5, a 2 or higher for Language Arts on your standards based report card is needed for reclassification. If your grade is lower, but you were eligible for reclassification based on your performance on the ELPAC and reading tests, you are eligible for the teacher appeal process. Note: There is no classification for Tk or K students.
